Massive open online courses (MOOCs) are gaining momentum all across the world in recent times ensuring access to quality education over the Web. In line with this, E-content development is also an important aspect. Considering the importance of MOOCs and E-content development, this Faculty Development Program aims to be a forum for the stakeholders to discuss and deliberate on the potential of these and their optimum utilisation in the field of education policy. Thus, this course aims at providing the knowledge and skill for teachers to cater to the needs of present-day learners and their learning styles. It will witness engaging sessions from various experts among stakeholders not only for sensitization but also for its effective implementation.

FDP Objectives

This FDP on MOOCs and E-content development aims at generating awareness among the participants and encouraging learning through such platform. It intends to create better and active communication and collaboration with the teachers and to design and manage learning assessment using Moodle MOOC Platform. It will help to understand the meaning and standards of E-content, learning objects, designing and development of digital resources for teaching and learning. This program aims at training the participants in understanding various categorical challenges involved in developing and implementing E-Contents. The FDP also involves hands-on experience on content development so as to make learning process more interactive. The other objectives of the programme are:
