For its effective implementation, RDC, Hansraj College seeks scientific contributions from every faculty in terms of writing research projects for funding, organizing training sessions and conferences, publishing research articles in reputed journals that are indexed in Scopus / Web of Science and encouraging students' innovative ideas and helping them in converting it to enterprise.

We take this opportunity to sincerely request all the faculty to get involved in quality research and publish the outcome of their research in Scopus-/Web of Science- indexed journals and kindly update RDC regarding the status of the manuscript (submitted / under review / accepted / published) twice a year, in the month of December and July.
