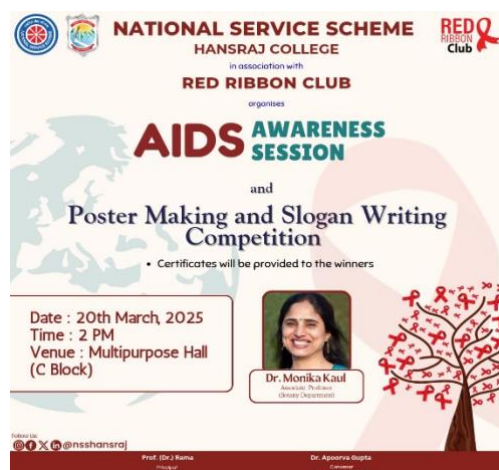
EVENT 2- AIDS AWARENESS SESSION WITH COLLEGE STUDENTS & SLOGAN WRITING CONTEST
