Description of Activity Conducted:

The National Integration Camp (NIC) 2024, as a part of the National Service Scheme, was organised by Choudhary Bansi Lal University(CBLU), Bhiwani, Haryana. Around 400 NSS Volunteers and 13 Programme Officers of different states participated in the National Integration Camp (NIC) 2024. Volunteers were from the universities of Karnataka, Punjab, Haryana, Jammu and Kashmir, Delhi, Jharkhand, Assam, Rajasthan, Maharashtra etc. The National Integration Camp (NIC) 2024 was held from 06-11-2024 to 12-11-2024 under the theme "Youth & My Bharat & Digital Literacy"

Day 1 (6th November, 2024)



Registration and Documentation of the volunteers and Program Officers were done on an arrival basis. At 4pm, the inauguration of the "National Integration Camp" commenced, with the lamp lighting in front of Maa Saraswati. The Venue of the NIC was Swami Vivekananda Auditorium, Vidyagram Campus of BRCM College, Behal, Bhiwani, Haryana. Professor Ramesh Chander Bhardwaj, Vice-Chancellor, Maharishi Balmiki Sanskrit University, Kaitha, was the chief guest, and Dr. Dipti Dharmani, Vice-Chancellor, Chaudhary Bansilal University, Bhiwan, was the distinguished guest of the inaugural function.
