### **Event Description:**

- The Online Extempore Competition was successfully conducted on 11th July 2025 via Google Meet by NSS Hansraj College to mark the observance of World Population Day. The event began promptly at 5:30 PM with a welcome address to all participants and judges.
- The judge of the event was Dr. Santoshi Bhawani Mishra, Assistant Professor, Department of English, Hansraj College and Dr. Apoorva Gupta, NSS Convener, NSS Unit, Hansraj College.
- The objective of the event was to promote awareness among students about key global issues related to population growth, environmental sustainability, and public responsibility.
- Participants were given topics on the spot based on the central theme — “Population, People, and the Planet” — and were allotted 1 minute to think and 2 minutes to speak. Topics were offered in both English and Hindi to ensure inclusivity and engagement.
- Over 30 participants registered for the competition. The event witnessed an engaging display of ideas, thoughtful insights, and confident public speaking. Topics such as “Is population a resource or a burden?”, “Kya jansankhya Bharat ki takat hai ya samasya?”, and “Women’s empowerment and population control” were met with bold and nuanced perspectives.
- The event highlighted the importance of youth awareness and expression in addressing contemporary issues like overpopulation, gender equality, and sustainable development.

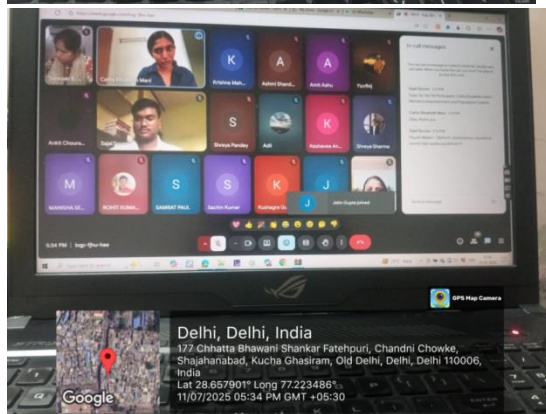
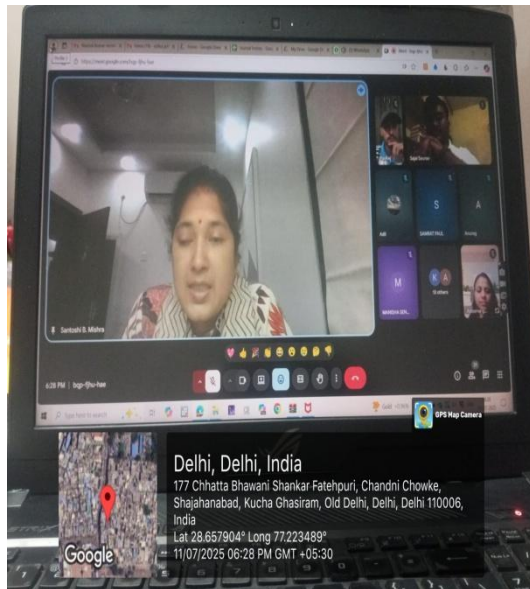
