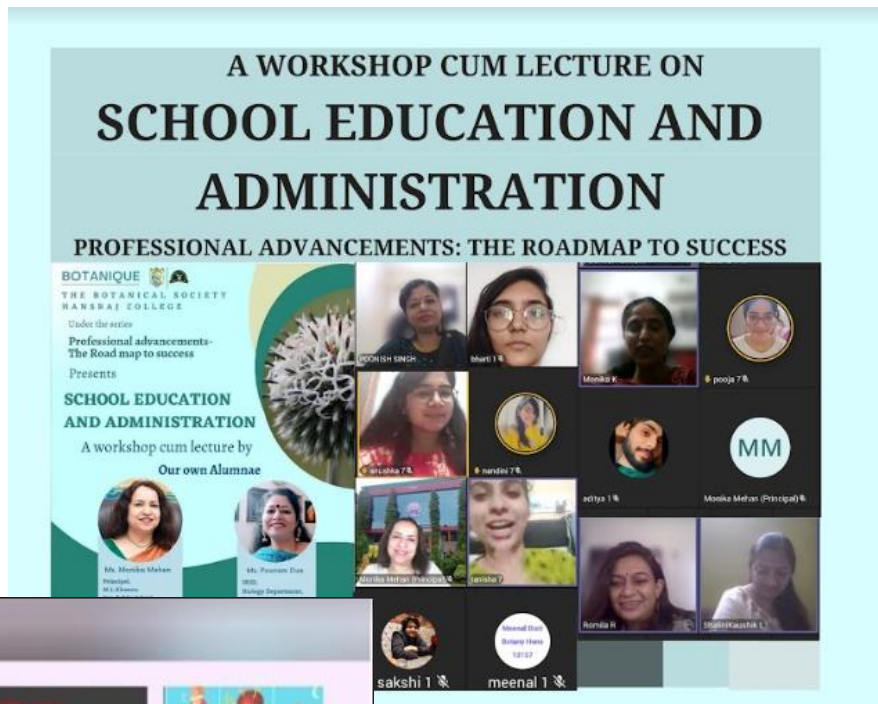

- HIV/AIDS bill, 2007
- HIV and AIDS (Prevention and control) bill, 2010
- Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) and Acquired Immune Deficiency (AIDS) Syndrome (Prevention and Control) Act, 2017 and much more.

RISK FACTORS

People who are at the high risk of getting infection are:-

- Individuals with multiple sexual partners
- Drug addict who take drugs intravenously
- Individuals who required repeated blood transfusion
- Children born to an HIV infected mother
- Tissue transplantation or medical procedures that involve unsterile cutting or pricking
- Having another sexually transmitted infection (STI), such as syphilis, gonorrhoea etc.

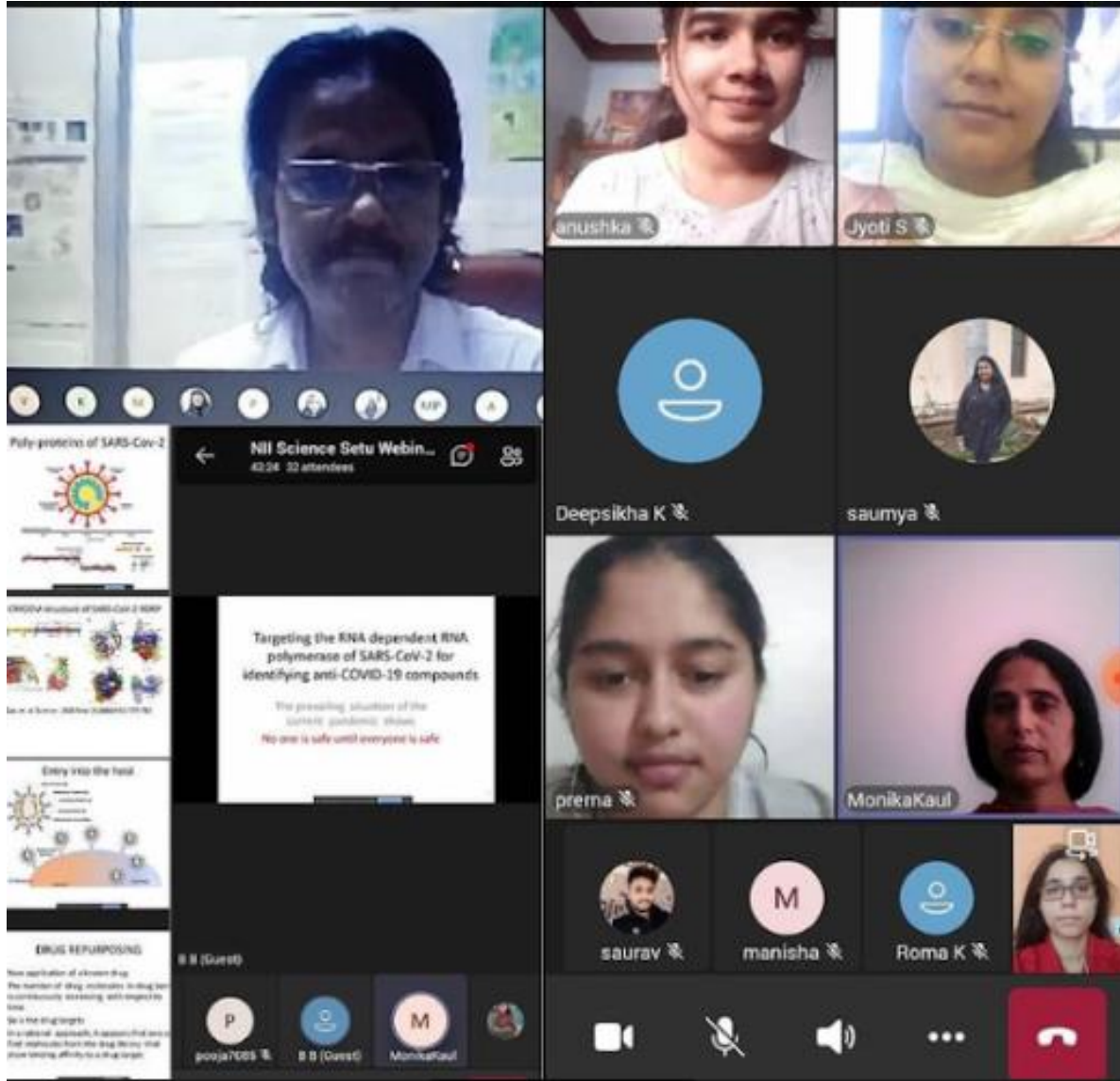
