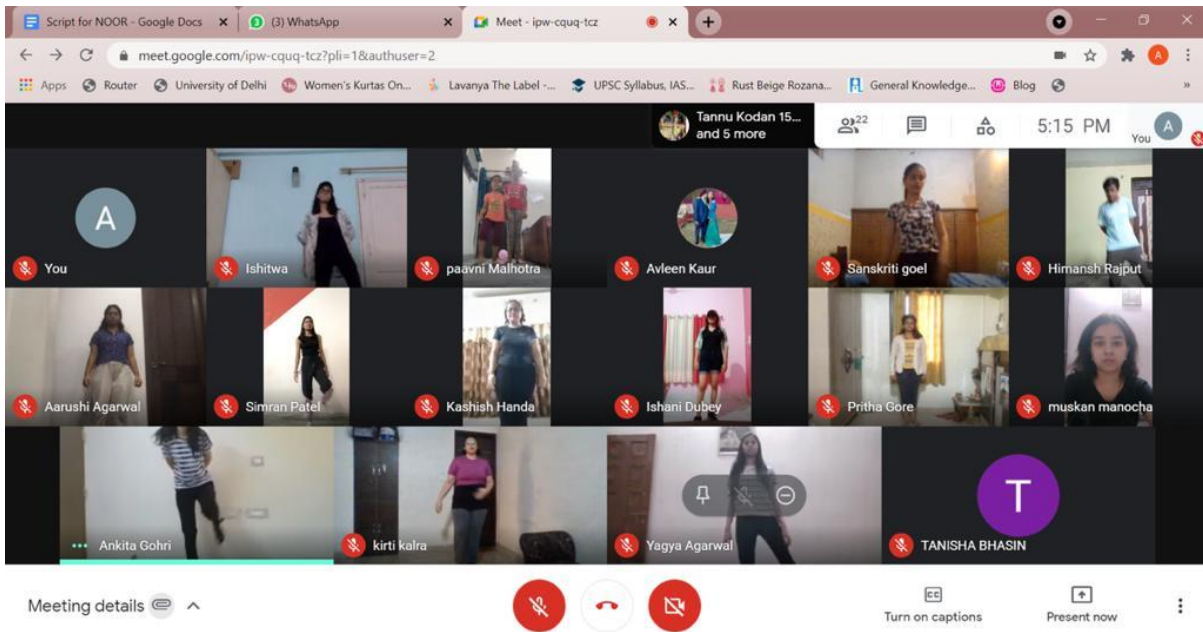

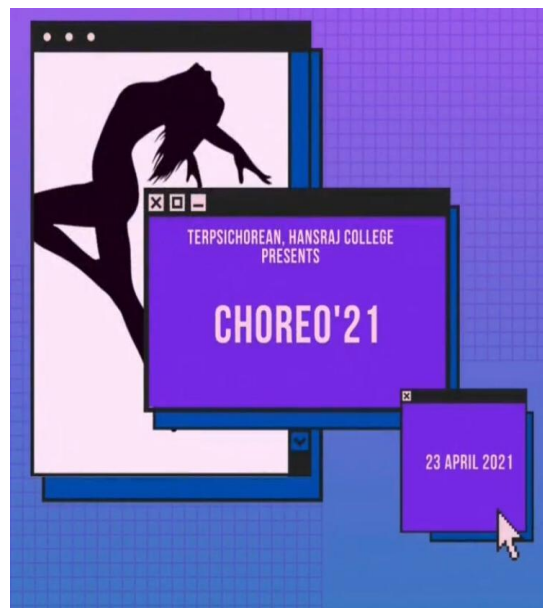
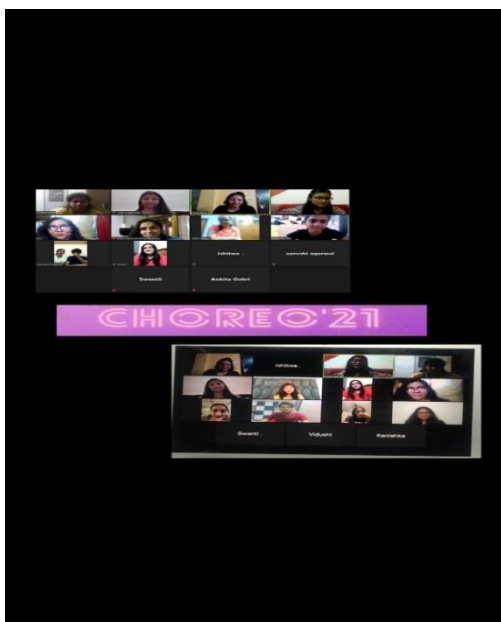
choreographing the dance and it was a thrilling experience for most of our team members as they took their first workshop.
