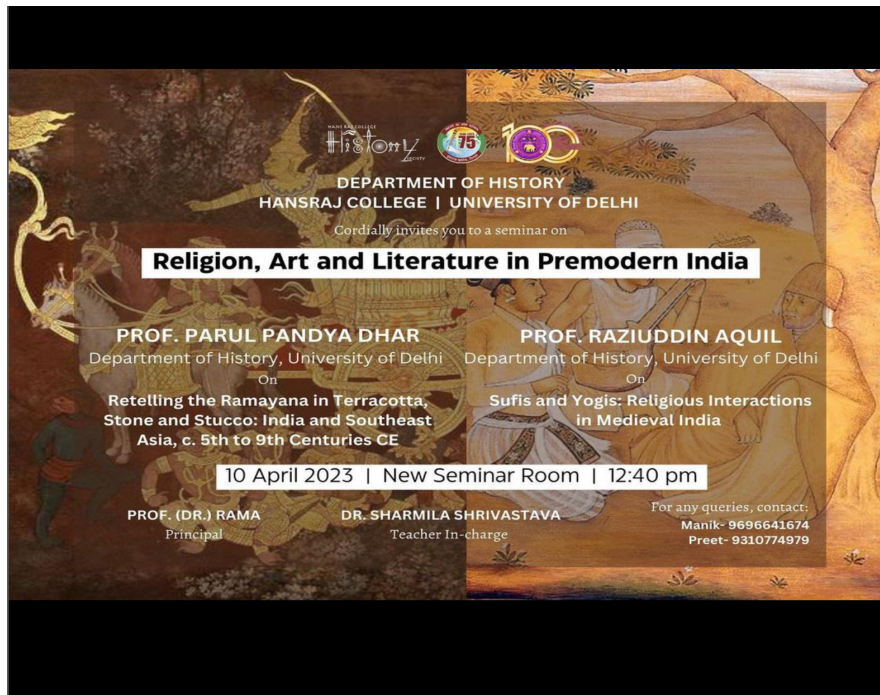

The Department of History, Hansraj College organized a one day seminar on the theme , ' Religion, Art and Literature in Pre-Modern India' with two eminent speakers, Prof. Parul Pandya Dhar (Department of History, University Of Delhi) and Prof. Raziuddin Aquil (Department of History, University Of Delhi). Prof. Parul Pandya Dhar, a well-known art historian spoke about the multiple retellings of Ramayana in South and South-East Asia through the medium of stone and terracotta figurines and other visual arts. She largely emphasised upon the need to break the monolithic understanding of Ramayan and look beyond at many many versions and retelling of Ramayana prevalent in the region. The following speaker Prof. Raziuddin Aquil, leading scholar of Medieval India further shared insights on the interactions between sufis and yogis and how these two communitis have debated and tolerated each other for centuries. A common question and answer session helped to further furnish our understanding about the theme. The event was graced by the presence of respected faculty members and students across university.
