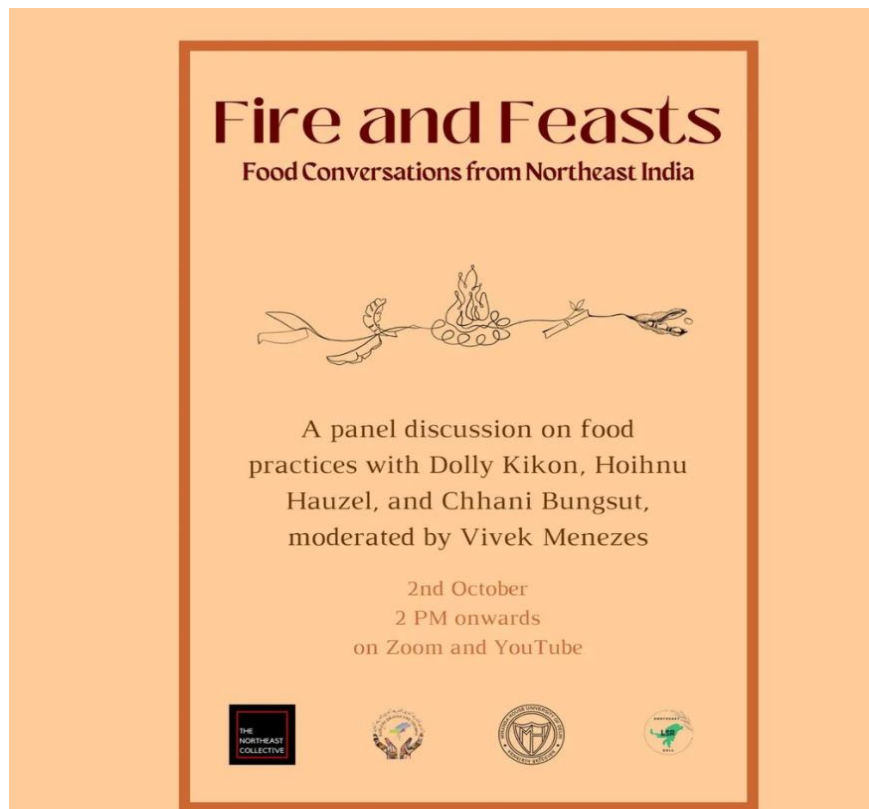
Name of the Event **5: Fire and Feasts 5: Food conversations from the North-East**

1. Dolly Kikon: Dolly Kikon is a Senior Lecturer in the department of Anthropology and Development Studies at the University of Melbourne. Her areas of expertise include gender studies, food cultures, human rights among others.
2. Hoihnu Hauzel: Hoihnu Hauzel is the founder of two digital entrepreneurial ventures in the Northeast. She is a certified professional by Le Cordon Bleu, Paris, for completing a course in Gastronomic Tourism and a recipient of the Reuters International News Writing Fellowship, London.
3. Chhani Bungsut: Chhani Bungsut is an aspiring researcher and writer. She is a recipient of The Zubaan-Sasakawa Peace Foundation Grants for Young Researchers from the Northeast 2021-2022. In her talk, she will be exploring what's Mizo about Mizo food.
