A brief description about the speakers is as follows-

Durjoy Dutta - He began his writing journey in college while pursuing engineering and wrote his first novel "Ofcourse, I Love You." Now, he is the author of 6 bestsellers, has contributed to 4 leading TV shows including the popular 'Sadda Haq- My Life, My Choice', co-founded a publishing house called 'Grapevine India', has been named as a 'Young Achiever' by The Times of India and has won the Teacher's Achievement Award.

Venkaiah Naidu - Mr. M Venkaiah Naidu, incumbent Union Minister of Housing and Urban Poverty alleviation and recipient of Skoch Lifetime Achievement Award was one of the keynote speakers for Empresa'17. Former National president and party secretary, he is not only the face of leadership but also the brain behind the mechanics of projects such as the 'Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana'.

Montek Singh Ahluwalia – He was felicitated with the Padma Vibhushan - India's second highest civilian honour for public service. A graduate from the Oxford University, the 'Division Chief' at the World Bank and 'Director of Evaluation Office' at IMF, a nurturing writer - this Indian Economist held the position of the Deputy Chairman of the Planning Commission of India (2004-14).

Rahul Tyagi - Initiating his career in the cyber world by hacking his own password 'onc3therewasacr0w', this BlackBerry Hall of famer has conducted over one hundred training sessions on cyber security globally. Mr. Tyagi has also been instrumental in highlighting the vulnerabilities on the websites of Intel, Sony, HP and many other corporations. Currently, the 29-year-old Indian is the vice president of Lucideus, an IT risk assessment and digital security service provider based in New Delhi.

There were over 350 people who attended the event, and it was appreciated by one and all as a discussion worthy to be attended.

'Prisonbreak-Narcos on Death Row' was another event set in the sinister world of crime, drugs, and money-making. The selected teams were required to strategise their way to escape custody. One member of the team donned the role of a bureaucrat while the other became a terrorist, and the two together had to manage resources amongst their groups to terrorise various locations of the national capital.
