Visits to NCDC (National Centre for Disease Control) Delhi were organised on 23rd and 24th January, 2019 for third year Zoology honours students. They were made aware of various communicable diseases and how surveillance and eradication programs are being planned and conduct under different situations in the entire country. The reorganized Institute was established to develop a national centre for teaching and research in various disciplines of epidemiology and control of communicable diseases. The Institute was envisaged to act as a centre par excellence for providing multi disciplinary and integrated expertise in the control of communicable disease. The Institute was also entrusted the task of developing reliable rapid economic epidemiological tools which could be effectively applied in the field for the control of communicable diseases. The objectives of the Institute broadly cover three activities - training, service and operational research in the field of communicable diseases and their prevention and control in the country.
