Written and directed by Vishal Srivastava, the movie revolves around a young trans woman's life who craves for love but is snubbed by other members of her community for having unrealistic expectations. The film ends on a positive note with the message that beauty is not determined by one's gender identity. It was followed by an enlightening panel discussion. Deepika shared her own experiences as a transgender person and the trauma faced by her due to social prejudices.

Next in series was a workshop on self-expression by Arpit Bhalla and Janees Lanker. It involved lots of fun filled activities related to how we express ourselves through symbols, lines of poetry and deep conversations with a random partner. After that Arpit Bhalla conducted a workshop on gender, sex and sexuality. The workshop gave a complete information about the three terms and explained how they hold different meanings. We also had special performances by Divya Dureja and Shabnam who touched our hearts with their performances.
