'विश्वविद्यालयी शिक्षा में शोध और नवाचार' विषयक सत्र में प्रो. राज नेहरू जी (कुलपति, श्री विश्वकर्मा स्मिथ यूनिवर्सिटी, हरियाणा सरकार) ने कहा कि हमारा चिंतन यह होना चाहिए कि 2047 का भारत कैसा होगा। मुकेश जी गुप्ता (अध्यक्ष, विज्ञान दिव्यांग फाउंडेशन) ने कहा कि राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति बहुत अच्छी है किंतु नीति के क्रियान्वयन की दिशा में आने वाली चुनौतियों को दूर करने में हंसराज परिवार की भी प्रभावी भूमिका होगी। प्रो. सत्यकेतु (कुलानुशासक, बी. आर. अम्बेडकर विश्वविद्यालय) ने कहा कि जिस शोध में नई चीज न हो, पुनरावृत्ति हो वह शोध नहीं है। 'भारतीय ज्ञान परंपरा और उच्च शिक्षा' विषय पर डॉ. सच्चिदानंद मिश्र ने कहा कि आज आवश्यकता इस बात की है कि भारत पुनः ज्ञान विज्ञान के क्षेत्र में अपने इतिहास के पन्ने पलटे।

सिद्ध हो सकता है। श्री रामेश्वर तेली, राज्यमंत्री, पेट्रोलियम एवं प्राकृतिक गैस ने कहा कि राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति 2020 के द्वारा बड़े बदलाव की नींव रखी जाएगी। इस सत्र में प्रो. श्रीप्रकाश सिंह, निदेशक, दक्षिणी परिसर, दिल्ली विश्वविद्यालय ने संस्कृत में लिखित ग्रंथों वेद, पुराण, उपनिषद का उल्लेख करते हुए कहा कि इन ग्रंथों में सदियों की ज्ञान परंपरा को सहेजा गया है। प्रो. गिरीश्वर मिश्र, पूर्व कुलपति, अंतरराष्ट्रीय हिंदी विश्वविद्यालय, वर्धा ने कहा कि शिक्षा का संबंध ज्ञान से है और ज्ञान भारतीय परंपरा में बहुत पवित्र माना गया है। डॉ. महेश चन्द्र शर्मा, अध्यक्ष, एकात्म मानवदर्शन अनुसंधान एवं विकास प्रतिष्ठान ने कहा कि हमें किताब के दायरे से बाहर निकलकर सवाल पूछने होंगे।

‘उच्च शिक्षा का अंतरराष्ट्रीयकरण’ विषयक सत्र में प्रो. चन्द्रशेखर, अध्यक्ष, अंतरराष्ट्रीय संबंध, दिल्ली विश्वविद्यालय ने कहा कि सामाजिक विकास का मुख्य माध्यम शिक्षा है। भारत की हर अंतरराष्ट्रीय उपलब्धि शिक्षा के द्वारा ही है। श्री सुभाष उत्तम देसाई, समाज कल्याण मंत्री, गोवा ने कहा कि आप सभी के अंदर बहुत क्षमता है, आवश्यकता है अपनी अंतर्निहित क्षमताओं को पहचानने की। प्रो. पवन



सिन्हा, आध्यात्मिक गुरु ने कहा कि मानसिक स्वास्थ्य आज के समय की बहुत बड़ी आवश्यकता है। राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति 2020 नैतिक, मानसिक, शारीरिक विकास पर बल दे दी है।

## महात्मा हंसराज स्मृति व्याख्यानमाला

हंसराज कॉलेज की स्थापना के अमृत वर्ष के उपलक्ष्य में आयोजित विविध कार्यक्रमों के अंतर्गत महात्मा हंसराज स्मृति व्याख्यानमाला का उद्घाटन व्याख्यान 23 अगस्त 2022 को "राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति और भारतीय भाषाएँ" विषय पर पुस्तकालय सभागार में आयोजित किया गया। इस अवसर पर मुख्य वक्ता के रूप में भारतीय भाषाओं की प्रोन्नति हेतु गठित उच्चाधिकार परामर्श समिति शिक्षा मंत्रालय, भारत सरकार के अध्यक्ष पद्मश्री चमू कृष्ण शास्त्री ने कहा कि भारतीय ज्ञान परंपरा और भारतीय भाषाएँ एक दूसरे से अनुस्यूत हैं। उन्होंने लोगों को भाषा के प्रति संवेदनशील होने के लिए प्रेरित किया। श्री शास्त्री ने भारतीय भाषा के विकास एवं भाषायी एकता को बढ़ाने के लिए कई महत्वपूर्ण पहलुओं जैसे माध्यम के रूप में भाषा, समकालीन साहित्य में भाषा, शिक्षण एवं अधिगम सामग्री सहित शोध हेतु भारतीय भाषाओं के प्रयोग पर बल देने के आवश्यकता पर बल दिया। उन्होंने उपस्थित लोगों से नवभारत निर्माण के संकल्प की सिद्धि हेतु भाषाई प्रयोग क्षेत्र का विस्तार करने का आह्वान किया। इसके उपरान्त संकल्प फाउंडेशन के अध्यक्ष श्री संतोष कुमार तनेजा जी ने चिकित्सा एवं इंजीनियरिंग सहित अन्य रोजगारोन्मुख पाठ्यक्रमों का अध्ययन अध्यापन भारतीय भाषाओं में होने की प्रक्रिया में हाल में आई गति को सामने रखा। उन्होंने कहा कि विश्व में सर्वाधिक धनी देश वही रहा है जहाँ शिक्षण एवं अधिगम का माध्यम वहाँ की भाषा रही है।

व्याख्यानमाला के अंतर्गत अलग अलग विषयों पर विविध व्याख्यानों का आयोजन किया गया। यूरोपीय संकट पर महत्वपूर्ण व्याख्यान वरिष्ठ विद्वान लार्ड मेघनाद देसाई का हुआ जिसमें उन्होंने भारतीय अर्थव्यवस्था की समकालीन दिशा और यूरोप के आलोक में कई बारीकियों को सामने रखा। इसी क्रम में एक दूसरे व्याख्यान में भारतीय ज्ञान परंपरा और गाँधी विषय पर सुप्रसिद्ध समाजशास्त्री प्रो. आनंद कुमार एवं प्रो. रमेश भद्राज जे ने अपने विचार रखते हुए समकालीन परिदृश्य के आलोक में भारतीय ज्ञान परंपरा के सम्बन्ध में गाँधी के विचार एवं उसकी प्रासंगिकता के विविध पक्षों को सामने रखा। वहीं आत्मनिर्भर भारत की चुनौतियाँ विषय पर सुप्रसिद्ध विचारक एवं स्वदेशी जागरण मंच के राष्ट्रीय सह संयोजक डॉ. अश्विनी महाजन ने आत्मा निर्भर भारत की दिशा में बढ़ रहे भारत के कदम एवं इसकी उपलब्धियों को सामने रखा। उन्होंने कहा की निर्माण एवं विनिर्माण के क्षेत्र में ही

नहीं रक्षा जैसे महत्वपूर्ण क्षेत्रों में भी भारत पहले से कहीं अधिक आत्मनिर्भर हुआ है और आने वाले समय में स्थिति और भी बेहतर होने वाली है। आत्मनिर्भर भारत को विश्वगुरु भारत से जोड़ते हुए उन्होंने इसे राष्ट्र की प्रगति के लिए बेहद आवश्यक माना। 'वर्तमान वैश्विक परिदृश्य और आध्यात्म' विषय पर व्याख्यान देते हुए अटल बिहारी वाजपेयी विश्वविद्यालय के कुलपति एडीएन वाजपेयी ने भारतीय आध्यात्म की व्यापकता और उसकी प्रासंगिकता के विविध आयामों को सामने रखते हुए कहा कि दुनिया की अधिकांश समस्याओं के समाधान का मार्ग भारतीय आध्यात्म और उसकी चेतना में सन्निहित है। तत्तरह के संघर्षों, टकराव से बाहर निकलने का ठोस उपाय भारतीय ज्ञान परंपरा, दर्शन और इसके आध्यात्मिक चिंतन में मौजूद है और विश्व समुदाय भी इस बात को भलीभाँति समझने लगा है।

व्याख्यानमाला के अंतर्गत एक महत्वपूर्ण व्याख्यान में सुप्रसिद्ध आध्यात्मिक गुरु, शिक्षाविद एवं चिन्तक प्रो. पवन सिन्हा 'गुरुजी' ने कहा कि राम की राज्य व्यवस्था और उससे सम्बंधित आदर्श आज भी प्रासंगिक हैं। व्याख्यानमाला के अंतर्गत 'आदर्श शासन और राम राज्य' विषय पर वक्तव्य देते हुए उन्होंने कहा कि वाल्मीकि रामायण का अध्ययन ऐतिहासिक सन्दर्भों के आलोक में करना चाहिए और इसमें वर्णित आदर्श शासन के विविध आयामों को अपना कर आधुनिक शासन व्यवस्था को बेहतर किया जा सकता है। उन्होंने आदर्श राजा के धर्म और उनकी मर्यादाओं का भी उल्लेख किया और कहा कि राजा को भी अपने शासन के दौरान धर्म का पालन करना चाहिए और यह धर्म सीधे-सीधे उनके कर्तव्य और आचरण से जुड़ा हुआ है। उन्होंने अयोध्या काण्ड के विविध प्रसंगों के माध्यम से यह स्थापित किया कि आदर्श राज्य के लिए सभी क्षेत्रों में आदर्श का पालन अपरिहार्य है।

इस अवसर खचारख भरे संगोष्ठी कक्ष में उन्होंने कहा कि प्राचीन भारतीय शासन व्यवस्था और रामायण काल में भी लोकतंत्र और लोकतांत्रिक मूल्यों का स्वरूप मिलता है। उन्होंने इस संबंध में अनेक उद्धरण भी दिए तथा युवाओं से भी यह आह्वान किया कि सोशल मीडिया के इस दौर में तब जबकि आभासी दुनिया का हमारे विचारों के निर्धारण में बहुत गहरा असर रहने लगा है, हमें तथ्यों की सही जांच-पड़ताल के बाद ही किसी निष्कर्ष पर पहुँचना चाहिए और उसके बाद ही अपनी प्रतिक्रिया देनी चाहिए। उन्होंने इस बात पर भी बल दिया कि रामायण और राम के चरित्र को समग्रता में समझना चाहिए और चुनिन्दा दोहों अथवा पंक्तियों के आधार पर किया गए विश्लेषण के आधार पर किसी निष्कर्ष पर पहुँचना बेहद घातक होता है।





### राष्ट्रीय संगोष्ठी: राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति और भारतीय भाषाएँ

आजादी का अमृत महोत्सव एवं हंसराज कॉलेज की स्थापना के 75वें वर्ष के उपलक्ष्य में भारतीय सामाजिक विज्ञान अनुसंधान परिषद, शिक्षा मंत्रालय, भारत सरकार एवं दिल्ली विश्वविद्यालय के हंसराज कॉलेज के संयुक्त तत्वाधान में दो दिवसीय राष्ट्रीय संगोष्ठी का आयोजन किया गया। 'राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति, भारतीय भाषाएँ एवं भविष्य की रणनीति' विषय पर 5-6 सितम्बर 2022 को आयोजित इस संगोष्ठी का उद्घाटन शिक्षा संस्कृति उत्थान न्यास के राष्ट्रीय सचिव अतुल भाई कोठारी ने किया। उद्घाटन सत्र में श्री कोठारी के अतिरिक्त केंद्रीय हिंदी शिक्षण मंडल, शिक्षा मंत्रालय, भारत सरकार के उपाध्यक्ष अनिल जोशी, राष्ट्रवादी विचारक एवं दिल्ली विश्वविद्यालय के राजनीति विज्ञान विभाग के अध्यक्ष प्रो. संगीत रागी भी थे। इस अवसर पर श्री कोठारी ने कहा कि राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति सामाजिक एवं शैक्षिक बदलाव की दृष्टि से दूरगामी परिणाम देने वाली होगी। श्री अनिल जोशी ने कहा कि भारतीय भाषाओं के संवर्धन से ही हिंदी और भारतीय ज्ञान परंपरा सुदृढ़ हो सकती है। वहीं प्रो. संगीत रागी ने कहा कि समावेशी शिक्षा अब भारत का ध्येय है और यही वैश्विक परिस्थितियों की मांग भी है। उद्घाटन सत्र के प्रारम्भ में हंसराज कॉलेज की

प्राचार्या प्रो. रमा ने संगोष्ठी के उद्देश्यों पर प्रकाश डालते हुए राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति के कार्यान्वयन में शिक्षा संस्थाओं की भूमिका को महत्वपूर्ण माना।

संगोष्ठी में प्रथम सत्र के वक्ता डॉ. जवाहर कर्नावट ने कहा कि केवल सरकारी प्रयासों और नीतियों से ही भारतीय भाषाओं का विकास नहीं हो सकता बल्कि यह आम जन की चिंता का विषय होना चाहिए, इसके बिना नई शिक्षा नीति में व्यक्त संकल्पों को सिद्धि तक नहीं पहुंचाया जा सकता है। इसी सत्र में राष्ट्रीय सहारा के राष्ट्रीय ब्यूरो प्रमुख श्री रोशन गौड़ ने भारतीय भाषाओं के पत्रकारिता को भी भाषिक संस्कार का ख्याल रखना चाहिए और इस संबंध में हमारा सजग होना भी बहुत आवश्यक है।

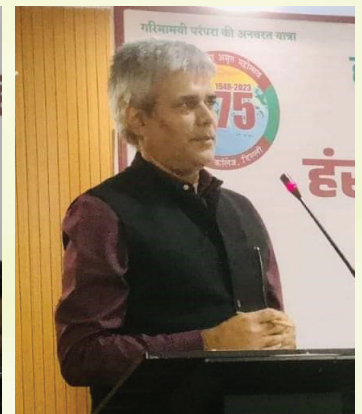

संगोष्ठी के समापन सत्र में वैज्ञानिक एवं तकनीकी शब्दावली आयोग के अध्यक्ष प्रो. गिरीश नाथ झा ने कहा कि भाषाओं में तकनीकी विकास एवं उपयोग की अपार संभावनाएँ हैं तथा भारतीय भाषाओं में यह क्षमता और अधिक है। इसलिए इस क्षेत्र में रोजगार की भी अपार संभावनाएँ हैं। इसी सत्र में राष्ट्रीय व्यावसायिक शिक्षा एवं प्रशिक्षण परिषद, कौशल विकास मंत्रालय, भारत सरकार के अध्यक्ष डॉ. निर्मलजीत सिंह कलसी ने राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति के कार्यान्वयन की रूपरेखा और इस दिशा में हो रहे प्रयासों को विस्तार से बताया और कहा कि इस शिक्षा नीति के कार्यान्वयन के बाद हमारी शिक्षा संरचना में आमूल चूल परिवर्तन दिखाई पड़ेगा। संगोष्ठी के समापन वक्तव्य में भारतविद एवं वरिष्ठ चिन्तक मनोज श्रीवास्तव ने दुनिया के विविध देशों में शिक्षा और भाषा मॉडल की चर्चा करते हुए भारतीय परंपरागत शिक्षा परंपरा को रेखांकित किया और कहा कि हमें अपनी शिक्षा और समाज व्यवस्था पर चिंतन करने की आवश्यकता है और राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति इसका पूरा अवकाश देती है।

A premier and foremost institution within the country—Hansraj College is one of the largest constituent colleges of Delhi University with over 5000 students. Constantly ranked amongst the top colleges in all three streams.

The 2022-23 Placement session managed to maintain its high placement statistics with 220+ companies including top consulting firms like Bain, Kearney, LEK, Accenture, ZS Associates, etc. offering a record number of 525+ offers across 19 different courses from the streams of Science, Commerce and Humanities, a sharp 54% rise over the previous year.

The highest package offered was 36.5 LPA, whereas the average package stood at 7.8+ LPA. The Gross Package increased by 56% YoY to reach 39 Cr. In addition to bringing a varied list of recruiters to campus.

Through the years, recruiters from the world's leading organizations have consistently reposed immense confidence in the exceptional capabilities of students that pass through these red brick walls. Recruiters from across various sectors such as Consulting, Finance, IT, Marketing and Sales. and HR visited the campus. The regular recruiters include companies such as Bain Capability Network, ZS Associates, Accenture S&C, Lek Capability Network, United Airlines, DeShaw and the Big 4.

In order to support the students' general growth, the Placement Cell also actively plans seminars and workshops, such as ones on how to prepare for CV creation, group discussions, and personal/case interviewing. These workshops are held to improve the Placement Cell's ability to assist career development and training, rather than focusing only on final placements.

In the session, 2022-23, National Service Scheme (NSS), Hansraj College organized several events for students and beneficiaries of the society. We organized programs on gender sensitization, mental health, plantation drive, cyber security session, cleanliness drive, career counseling for Padhaku kids, cloth and blanket donation drive, dengue and hygiene related awareness, plogging drive, cancer run, blood donation camp, health checkup camps, visits to orphanage, old age home and transgender shelter home. The Cell has also organized workshops to help students develop their professional skills, such as communication, teamwork, and leadership.

The annual flagship event—the Internship Fair 2023—a 4-day (3rd-6th April) Pan-India event was organized under the leadership of the Chief coordinators- Aastha Agarwal, Lakshay Saini, Muskan Arora, Sanya Gupta and Tejika Bajaj. Marking its commencement with Speaker Session- CorporateXpo by Sushant Bindal, Himani Choudhari and Shivani Narula covering the Importance of Internships and Insightful tips, the event proved to be a great success. 180 Degrees Consulting is a university-based consultancy that specializes in providing services to non-profits and social enterprises. Since our Hansraj branch opened in August 2018, we have successfully completed more than 22 projects and continued to create a significant impact this year as well. We began the 2022-23 session with a core team of five members and a senior consultant team of 13 members. Our first project, which commenced in August 2022, was in collaboration with a global healthcare NGO that was working on treating the defect of ClubFoot in India. The project lasted for four months and was divided into five verticals with two project managers assigned to each. We conducted a thorough impact assessment to gain insight into the current state of the organization, following which we developed an expansion strategy that focused on enhancing program penetration and awareness while also re-engineering processes to improve internal efficiency and received a client feedback rating of 9/10 for this project. In November and December, we began our recruitment drive for incoming junior consultants, including a formal orientation and an informal event called “consultancy unwrapped” that featured various consulting-related activities. In January 2023, we onboarded a team of 38 junior consultants and organized a bootcamp which covered various topics right from research methodologies to guesstimates & frameworks. In February, we also organized one of the DU circuit’s prestigious case competitions, Curious Case 5 with 1600+ registrations. We have started our new project cycle in the month of April with 3 impactful projects.

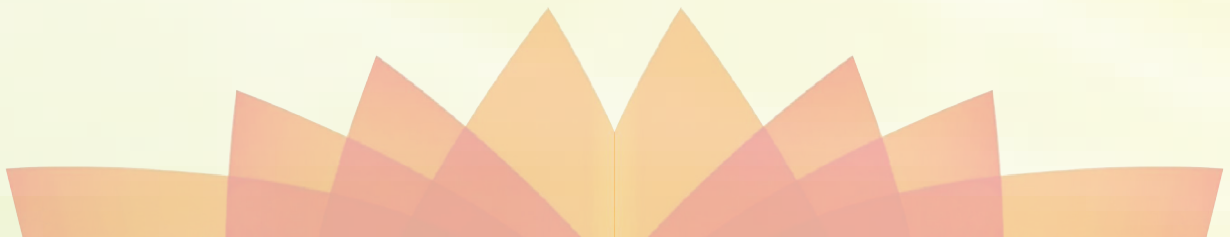
