## विकास के चरण

हंसराज कॉलेज विकास निधि समिति ने शैक्षणिक वर्ष 2024-2025 के दौरान संस्थान के बुनियादी ढांचे के निरंतर संवर्द्धन में महत्वपूर्ण भूमिका निभाई। समिति ने इस वर्ष शैक्षणिक, आवासीय और प्रशासनिक ढांचों को बेहतर बनाने पर विशेष ध्यान केंद्रित किया। सुरक्षा उपायों को मजबूत करने, सुविधाओं को आधुनिक बनाने और पूरे परिसर में महत्वपूर्ण प्रणालियों के निर्बाध संचालन को सुनिश्चित करने की दिशा में अनेक प्रयास किए गए। इनमें मौजूदा बुनियादी ढांचे के रखरखाव और उसके उन्नयन, आवश्यक उपकरणों की खरीद, जीर्णोद्धार सहित प्रमुख सेवा अनुबंधों के लिए निविदाओं का विस्तार भी शामिल था। कॉलेज परिसर की गुणवत्ता और कार्यक्षमता को बनाए रखने के लिए अनेक पहल किए गए, जैसे ट्रांसलेशनल ऑन्कोलॉजी प्रयोगशाला, ए-ब्लॉक और डे केयर सुविधा सहित विभिन्न स्थानों पर सीसीटीवी कैमरों की स्थापना।

For the academic year 2024-25, the Department's academic activities commenced with an orientation session for first-year students. The Society hosted a one-day workshop on 'Gender and Historical Thinking', featuring distinguished scholars: Prof. Shalini Sha (Department of History, DU), Prof. Aparna Balachandran (Department of History, DU), and Dr. Rachana Chaudhary (AUD, Delhi), who conducted sessions on methodologies for studying gender history. In October 2024, Prof. Mridula Mukherjee (JNU, Delhi) delivered a lecture on Mahatma Gandhi's idea of Swaraj. This training program included a lecture on sustainability of solar energy by an eminent faculty and a tour to the working model designed by the institute.

A seminar was organised on "Throwing Light on Dark Matter" on 23 October 2024. Eminent faculty member Prof. Amitabha Mukherjee, a retired professor of the Department of Physics and Astrophysics, Delhi University, was invited to deliver the talk. The seminar aimed to introduce cosmology to the audience, and throwed light on black matter, which has been and continues to be a fundamental question in cosmology.

National Science day on 27, 28th Feb 2025, where students participated actively in the power point presentation competition and science games. On 28th Feb 2025, some of our students visited Inter University Accelerator Centre and participated in one day program where they got an opportunity to visit their labs.

संस्कृत साहित्य परिषद् ने अकादमिक वर्ष 2024-25 के अंतर्गत छात्रों के निमित्त अनेक व्याख्यान, प्रतियोगिताएं, शिविर आदि का आयोजन किया। सत्रारम्भ में 13 सितंबर 2024 को श्री विनोद आनन्द के द्वारा "श्रीमद्भगवत् में भक्तिस्मिन्त" विषय पर व्याख्यान आयोजित किया गया। तदनन्तर परिषद् के द्वारा संस्कृत भाषा के व्यवहार प्रयोगार्थ दश दिवसीय संस्कृत संभाषण का आयोजन संस्कृत भारती के साथ संयुक्त तत्वावधान में हुआ जो 07 अक्टूबर को प्रारंभ होकर 18 अक्टूबर को संपन्न हुआ।

इसी मध्य 14 अक्टूबर पर प्रो. विनय कुमार विद्यालंकार और प्रो. ओम नाथ बिमली के मार्गदर्शन में परिषद् ने "भारतीय दर्शन में त्रैतवाद एवं दयानन्द सरस्वती" विषय पर व्याख्यान आयोजित किया गया। स्वाध्याय शृंखला के अंतर्गत प्रतिस्पर्धादर्पण, पाणिनीय तंत्र में जीवन बोध विषयक चर्चा, प्रो. रंजीत कुमार मिश्र के सान्निध्य में छात्रों ने "संघ लोक सेवा आयोग और संस्कृत" विषय पर ज्ञानार्जन किया। तत्पश्चात् श्री ऋषभ कुणाल के द्वारा 17 फरवरी 2025 को "संस्कृत में नेट/ जे आर एफ" विषय पर कार्यशाला हुई और 18 फरवरी को महाभारत आधारित प्रश्नोत्तरी का भी आयोजन हुआ, इस प्रकार इस सत्र में 5 स्वाध्याय पूर्ण हुए। आनलाईन माध्यम से श्री सोमनाथ संस्कृत विश्वविद्यालय के डॉ. जीगर भट्ट ने 13 जनवरी 2025 को छात्रों के समक्ष "संस्कृतकाव्यनिर्माणाय आवश्यक कौशल" विषय पर व्याख्यान प्रस्तुत किया। ततः परम् 27 जनवरी 2025 को सेंट स्टीफेंस महाविद्यालय के डॉ. अभय सिंह ने "संस्कृत भाषा में लिंग विमर्श" विषयक चर्चा प्रस्तुत की। 24 फरवरी को नवागंतुक छात्रों के लिए विभागीय संवाद का आयोजन हुआ जहां खुशी और लक्की पुरस्कृत हुए। 02 मार्च को विभागाध्यक्ष डॉ. ब्रह्म प्रकाश, संयोजक डॉ. अरुण कुमार एवं डॉ. ज्ञान श्री के साथ परिषद् के 40 छात्रों ने आगरा और फतेहपुर सीकरी का शैक्षणिक भ्रमण भी किया। 09 अप्रैल 2025 को विभाग का वार्षिकोत्सव निकष'25 का आयोजन हुआ जिसके अंतर्गत भाषण, श्लोकावृत्ति और प्रश्नमंच का आयोजन किया गया।

संस्कृत साहित्य परिषद् के विद्यार्थियों ने इस सत्र में विभिन्न प्रतियोगिताओं में 15 पुरस्कार प्राप्त किये जिसमें आदर्श और सुनील ने प्रश्नमंच (स्टेफिन्स कॉलेज) में प्रथम, प्रेमजीत श्लोकावृत्ति (वेकेश्वर कॉलेज) में तृतीय और रजत ने नृत्य में IIT कानपुर में द्वितीय स्थान प्राप्त किया। छात्रों द्वारा संस्कृत भाषा के संवर्धन हेतु संचालित विवक्षुगण की संलापशाला ने अपने एकवर्ष में 325 संलापशालाएं पूर्ण की। इस प्रकार यह सत्र संस्कृतमय व्याख्यान और गतिविधियों से परिपूर्ण रहा। संस्कृत के संवर्धन, सम्पोषण और संरक्षण हेतु संस्कृत साहित्य परिषद् प्रतिबद्ध है।

Srishti Chetna, the Zoological Society of Hansraj College, hosted a series of enriching events throughout the year. The session began with a hands-on workshop on "ABC of NGS Data Analysis" (29th July-1st August 2024), led by alumna Riya Madan, introducing students to sequencing data analysis. On 30th August 2024, the society welcomed new students through an engaging Orientation Session.

To celebrate National Wildlife Day (3rd-5th October 2024), Srishti Chetna, in collaboration with Haritima: The Environmental Society, organized a three-day event, featuring experts like Mr. Baiju Raj (Wildlife SOS) and Dr. Samir Kumar Sinha (WTI), who discussed biodiversity conservation and human-wildlife coexistence. Six students were selected for an internship at the Elephant Conservation and Care Centre in Mathura.

On 9th October 2024, a Mental Health and Well-being session was held with expert talks on gynaecological health by Dr. Purna Lakhwani (Fortis Hospital) and lifestyle diseases by Dr. Sanjay Dhall (Max Hospital). A parallel health camp provided free check-ups for students and faculty.

The society also organized an international seminar on immunology by Prof. Uday Kishore (Brunel University) on 18th November 2024 and another on global opportunities by Dr. Shibashish Giri (UK) on 11th February 2025.

Department also organised an outreach program on "microbial literacy" for school students, academic trips to the National Zoological Park and National Institute of Immunology respectively along with National science day events for students.

Srishti Chetna events have successfully blended research, education, mental health awareness, and conservation.

युवा अपने विचारों और सुझावों को साझा करें और विकसित भारत के निर्माण में अपना योगदान दें। युवाओं से इस आशय की अपील दिल्ली विश्वविद्यालय के हंसराज कॉलेज में विकसित भारत युवा कनेक्ट कार्यक्रम के अवसर पर मुख्य वक्ता केंद्रीय संसदीय और अल्पसंख्यक मामलों के मंत्री किरेन रिजिजू ने की। हंसराज कॉलेज के पूर्व विद्यार्थी एवं केंद्रीय मंत्री किरेन रिजिजू ने भारत सरकार के युवा कार्यक्रम एवं खेल मंत्रालय द्वारा आयोजित युवा कनेक्ट के तहत हंसराज कॉलेज के युवा विद्यार्थियों के साथ संवाद किया। इस अवसर पर उन्होंने विकसित भारत अभियान के विभिन्न पक्षों और सरकार के रोड मैप को युवाओं के बीच रखवा तथा पीएम मोदी के विकसित भारत के संकल्प को सिद्धि तक पहुंचाने के लिए युवाओं से भी इसमें शामिल होने का आग्रह किया। विकसित भारत अभियान का उद्देश्य आजादी के 100वें वर्ष यानी वर्ष 2047 तक भारत को एक विकसित राष्ट्र बनाना है।

### COUNSELLING UNIT

SENIOR PSYCHOLOGIST: RACHEL ALICE



The Counselling Unit was established in December 2022 by Rachel Alice (M.A. Psy., B.Ed) under the leadership of our Principal, Prof. Dr. Rama, to provide psychological support and guidance to students. Mehar Pruthi (M.Sc. Psy.) joined in April 2024, further strengthening the unit's services. Since its inception, the unit has been actively addressing academic, emotional and personal challenges through free of cost individual counselling, group therapy and psychoeducational workshops.

The unit also conducts mental health awareness programs and crisis interventions for students and staff, ensuring timely referrals when needed. We also have a student body of 20+ students training as first responders and mental health advocacy. Other initiatives include workshops in collaboration with other societies, art therapy sessions, monthly campaigns, monthly e-newsletters and our biannual magazine 'Hans Hues'.

Although Hansraj College doesn't offer psychology as a degree programme, the unit offers flagship certificate courses for practising psychotherapists and students interested in psychology to enhance professional development. This includes certificate courses in Trauma-Informed Psychosocial Care and Psychodynamic and Psychosocial Studies, created by Rachel Alice and Queer Affirmative Mental Health developed by Mehar Pruthi.

The Counselling Unit at Hansraj College remains committed to fostering a stigma-free, supportive and inclusive space for personal and academic growth of all students.

### GANDHI ADHYAYAN KENDRA

This is the annual report of events conducted by Gandhi Adhyayan Kendra, Hansraj College for academic year 2024-25.

On 1st October 2024, a thought-provoking essay writing competition was held, which aimed to explore "the relevance of Mahatma Gandhi in today's world of advanced technology and rapid globalization". The event provided a platform for students to reflect on Gandhi's timeless principles and to assess their significance in a world that has dramatically changed since his time. The topic for the competition was "Gandhi's Relevance in the Age of Technology and Globalization." A highlight of the event was the address by the president of the society, who emphasized the importance of embracing Gandhian principles in today's world, urging students to reflect deeply on the themes of simplicity, non-violence, and truth in their essays. Professor Puri meticulously dissected the central moral tenets underpinning Gandhi's philosophy—Satya (truth), Ahimsa (non-violence), Daya (compassion), and Abhay dan (fearlessness). Her lecture was enriched with references to seminal texts such as Young India and Hind Swaraj, providing the audience with a robust intellectual foundation for comprehending Gandhi's enduring influence.

This seminar was both a celebration of Gandhi's life and legacy and a reminder of the enduring relevance of his teachings in today's context.

अत्यंत हर्ष का विषय है कि हंसराज महाविद्यालय में दिल्ली विश्वविद्यालय की प्रथम संस्कृत वाद-विवाद समिति "वागवर्धिनी" की स्थापना 02 दिसम्बर 2024 को हुई। संस्कृत भाषा में वाद-विवाद की परम्परा को पुनः आरंभ करना इसका लक्ष्य है। समिति का अनावरण 25 जनवरी 2025 को श्री शांति नारायण स्मृति वाद-विवाद प्रतियोगिता के आयोजन के साथ हुआ। प्राचार्या, समन्वयक एवं विशिष्ट अतिथि ने समिति के संविधान का अनावरण भी किया। समिति का ध्येय वाक्य "वादे वादे जायते तत्त्वबोधाः" की उद्धोषणा के साथ समिति ने अपना कुलगीत भी प्रस्तुत किया जिसके लेखक दंडपाणि आचार्य और कुमार आदर्श थे। समिति के संविधान सभा के संरक्षक संस्कृत विभाग के प्राध्यापक डॉ. अतनीश कुमार थे जिनके मार्गदर्शन में सृष्टि, चेतना, आयुषी, कुमार आदर्श, राकेश और ओंकार ने इस संविधान का निर्माण किया। उसी दिन देश के विभिन्न संस्थाओं से 15 दलों ने संस्कृत वाद-विवाद प्रतियोगिता में प्रतिभाग किया जिसमें संस्कृत विभाग के छात्र ऋषभ कुणाल को प्रथम पुरस्कार प्राप्त हुआ। प्राचार्या ने अपनी प्रसन्नता व्यक्त करते हुए कहा कि संस्कृत भाषा के प्रयोग में जुटे इन छात्रों को देखकर संस्कृत की लोक में पुनर्स्थापना निश्चित है। प्राचार्या ने समिति के संस्थापक छात्र कुमार आदर्श के परिश्रम और कर्मठता की प्रशंसा की। इस कार्यक्रम में दूरदर्शन से डॉ. नारायण दत्त मिश्र मुख्य अतिथि थे और डॉ. पंकज कुमार मिश्र ने "भारतीय ज्ञान परम्परा में वाद" इस विषय पर छात्रों का मार्गदर्शन किया।

Project Mehr addressed floral pollution by developing natural dyeing techniques and eco-friendly products in partnership with Gulmeher NGO.

The upcoming Project Nirmal focuses on reducing algae growth in the Yamuna River and producing eco-friendly cleaners while supporting acid attack survivors. Research initiatives explored bioplastic production from red algae, bio-enzyme cleaners, and sustainable products using coffee grounds, agricultural waste, and citrus peels.

An IQAC Academic Centre formally set-up in 2020, the Student Learning Centre continues to instill the spirit of knowledge-sharing among students, develop contemporary soft skills, and assist students with learning gaps and to cater students with research interests during the academic session.

A 32-hour Add-on certificate course on Machine Learning was held in hybrid mode from October 6th to November 24th, 2023, to provide students with machine learning skills that they can apply to real-world problems and explore the complexities of the AI world.

An Online Workshop on Business Analytics: Sentiment Analysis Using R Studio was held from the 7th to the 8th of October 2023 in collaboration with the Commerce Department to familiarize students with the available tools for business analytics, specifically for textual data.

From October 9th to October 13th, 2023, a peer-to-peer training workshop was held in collaboration with Rajbhasha Karyanvayan Samiti, in which physical science students mentored students from the Hindi department on how to use Microsoft office tools.

A training workshop was conducted on Introduction to QGIS and image processing in association with Mahatma Hansraj Faculty Development Centre and Miranda House College from 30th October to 6th November 2023.

A seminar on Statistics of Finite Level Systems was held on February 22, 2024, in collaboration with the Department of Physics and Electronics. The seminar shared concepts and knowledge to assist students in unraveling the hidden patterns of the universe.

The peer-to-peer mentoring programme was continued in several departments to facilitate remedial classes to provide academic support to students and reduce learning gaps in their subject.
