संघर्ष क्षेत्र एवं प्राकृतिक आपदाओं से प्रभावित क्षेत्रों में महिलाओं के खिलाफ अपराध

राष्ट्रीय महिला आयोग एवं महिला विकास केंद्र, हंसराज कॉलेज द्वारा 31 जनवरी 2020 को हंसराज कॉलेज के संगोष्ठी कक्ष में राष्ट्रीय संगोष्ठी का आयोजन किया गया। 'संघर्ष क्षेत्र एवं प्राकृतिक आपदाओं से प्रभावित क्षेत्रों में महिलाओं के खिलाफ अपराध' विषयक उक्त संगोष्ठी में अनेक विद्वान वक्ताओं ने अपने महत्वपूर्ण वक्तव्य दिए। संगोष्ठी के प्रारंभ में हंसराज कॉलेज की प्राचार्या एवं संगोष्ठी संयोजिका प्रो. रमा ने उद्घाटन वक्तव्य देते हुए कहा कि भारतीय महिलाओं महिलाओं के लिए परिवेश को और अधिक अनुकूल बनाने के लिए लड़कों के बीच सही मानदंडों को विकसित करने की आवश्यकता है। संगोष्ठी में अपना बीज वक्तव्य देते हुए सुप्रसिद्ध मनोवैज्ञानिक डॉ. अरुणा ब्रूटा ने कहा कि महिलाओं के खिलाफ अपराध को बढ़ावा देने वाले मूल दृष्टिकोण और धारणाओं में सेंध लगाना एक दुर्जेय कार्य है क्योंकि न केवल महिलाओं की बल्कि पुरुषों की भी काउंसलिंग की जानी चाहिए और लैंगिक समानता और सामाजिकता को बढ़ावा देने वाले मानदंडों का पालन करना चाहिए। डॉ. ब्रूटा ने उस समाज में महिलाओं के खिलाफ अपराध की व्यापकता पर सवाल उठाया। उन्होंने सवाल किया कि क्या महिलाओं के बिना किसी समाज पर विचार या कल्पना की जा सकती है। डॉ. ब्रूटा ने स्वामी विवेकानंद का हवाला देते हुए पुरुषों से महिलाओं को अकेला छोड़ने का आग्रह किया ताकि वे अपना रास्ता निकाल सकें। विशिष्ट अतिथि के रूप में दिल्ली विश्वविद्यालय के शहीद राजगुरु कॉलेज ऑफ एप्लाइड साइंसेज की प्राचार्या डॉ. पायल मग्गो ने भी संगोष्ठी को

संबोधित किया। उन्होंने समाज में महिलाओं की स्थिति में सकारात्मक बदलाव के लिए सरकार के साथ साथ समाज को खासकर महिलाओं के द्वारा पहल की आवश्यकता पर बल दिया।

इसके बाद 'महिलाओं के खिलाफ अपराध: विभिन्न आयाम' विषयक सत्र में दूरदर्शन के सुप्रसिद्ध एंकर श्री अशोक श्रीवास्तव ने महिलाओं के खिलाफ अपराधों को रोकने के लिए कड़े कानूनों की आवश्यकता पर चर्चा की। पहले सत्र की दूसरी वक्ता डॉ. वर्तिका नंदा ने उन बलात्कार पीड़ितों की चर्चा की जो जीवित थे और समाज जिन्हें पुनः स्थापित होने की आवश्यकता थी। उन्होंने महिलाओं के खिलाफ अपराधों के विभिन्न रूपों जैसे साइबर अपराध और घरेलू हिंसा पर भी चर्चा की।

इसके बाद 'महिला और महिला सशक्तिकरण के खिलाफ अपराध' विषयक सत्र में पानीपत में वकील सीमा सैनी तर्क दिया कि भारतीय समाज में महिलाओं के प्रति हिंसा गहराई से अंतर्निहित थी। इनमें कम चर्चा वाली डायन शिकार जैसी प्रथा शामिल थी। इसी सत्र में पत्रकार एवं सामाजिक कार्यकर्ता भाषा सिंह ने जन ,जंगल और जमीन के विवाद को संघर्ष के अंतर्निहित कारणों के रूप में पहचाना। उन्होंने कहा कि ऐसी परिस्थितियों में महिलाओं की बुनियादी भौतिक सुरक्षा से समझौता किया जाता है। उन्होंने संवैधानिक प्रावधानों के लिए संघर्ष की जरूरत भी दोहराई। इसी सत्र में प्रो. आनंद प्रधान ने महिलाओं को न्यूज़रूम और संपादकीय पदों पर रखने की आवश्यकता का आग्रह किया ताकि वे सूचना और राय को निर्धारित कर सकें और आकार दे सकें। आदिवासी और विस्थापित भी इन पदों पर नहीं हैं। उन्होंने भारत में समाचार पत्रों और टीवी समाचार चैनलों में महिला संपादक की पूर्ण अनुपस्थिति का खुलासा किया। उन्होंने जोर देकर कहा कि संघर्ष क्षेत्रों में आघातग्रस्त महिलाएं पुरुष पत्रकारों के साथ अपनी स्थिति साझा नहीं करती हैं।

संगोष्ठी के समापन सत्र में सभी सहभागिता प्रमाण-पत्र प्रदान किया गया। कार्यक्रम समन्वयक एवं हंसराज कॉलेज महिला विकास केंद्र की प्रभारी कपिला मल्लाह ने सभी वक्ताओं एवं सहभागियों का धन्यवाद ज्ञापन किया।

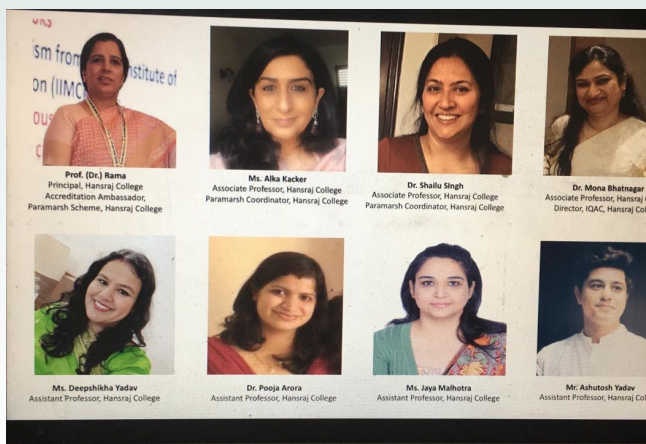

The cell received 120+ job offers in phase 1, with a gross package value of 8.8+ crores with more than 40% of the total companies visiting the campus for the first time.

The highest package was 18 LPA, offered by DE Shaw followed by Futures First, a first-time recruiter, extending out an offer of 12.4 LPA. The Placement Cell observed a 70% increase in Off-Campus Opportunities, thereby assisting maximum students in obtaining placements in reputed companies. CV Vetting was also introduced in this session, to ensure a fair and authentic placement drive.

Edifice – The Knowledge and Development Centre of Placement Cell, successfully conducted various informative sessions this year. 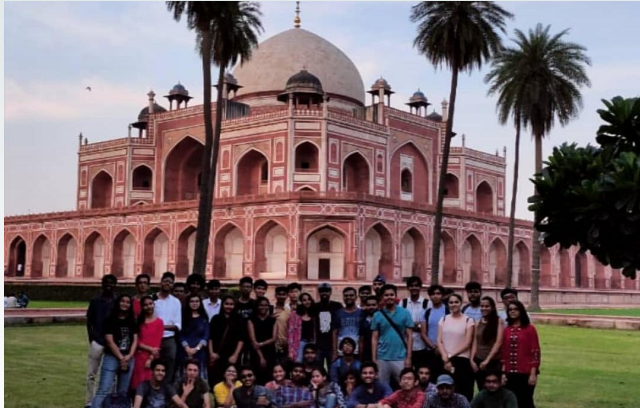

Enactus Hansraj works on social entrepreneurship to make a positive impact on the world. Project Armaan, our latest endeavour, collaborated with two organizations—Reawakening Wellness Foundation and Muskaan Foundation—working in the field of substance de-addiction. A unique product line for our target community came about which incorporates upcycling of waste tyres.

Enactus collaborated with NDDTC (AIIMS) and the Society for Promotion of Youth and Masses (SPYM) for setting up rehabilitation centres for child drug addicts. The first centre, set up in August 2019, was situated at the Old Delhi Railway Station. The USP of our framework is the Growth and Analysis Tracker and a specially curated curriculum developed after months of research, with multiple psychologists.



Project Ahsaas established a new centre at Ashadeep Foundation, with our entrepreneur getting a fixed pay of Rs. 10,000 and 32 children getting access to computer education. Three new service centres are in the process of opening for digital education of hundreds of children while creating more employment opportunities. A production vertical involving all disabilities was added to this project. Two upcoming production centres will see our entrepreneurs making products by upcycling denim, under the brand name 'Denims by Ahsaas'.

Project Vriddhi, covered by esteemed newspapers like The Indian Express, organised farmers into an FPO i.e. Harsana Kalan Farmer Producer Company, with over 100 members facilitating a sale of around 2,00,000 kgs of mushroom through industry tie-ups. In our handicraft vertical, 20 women entrepreneurs are engaged in making products and earning livelihood under a pre-order commission-based model. Through our final vertical, we established our first stubble-made washroom in Arthala to curb open defecation.

The Department of Botany took this initiative to carry forward the flambeau of environmental conservation. The Club has now found its warriors across disciplines and subjects. Dr. A.K. Singh, Head of the Department of Genetics, IARI Delhi inaugurated the club by planting a sapling.

A Plant Adoption Campaign was started wherein students adopted the plants with a pledge to rear them for six months to help them survive and establish. The Club also collaborated with NGOs & “Being Green” and “Give Me Trees Foundation”, to plant saplings and spread the green movement across Delhi-NCR.. Further, to promote plantations, a plant give away drive was organized providing people with native plants for free. So far, around 500+ saplings have been planted by the club members all over Delhi.

A “Waste Collection Drive” under project Eco-Bricks, was undertaken in collaboration with “Give Me Trees Foundation”, and served as a step towards elimination of plastic waste. An Eco-brick is a plastic bottle packed with used plastic collected from homes, offices etc. to a set density to create a reusable building block.

The club initiated a project with “Society for Child Development” by restoring, greening and renovating their premises. Reclamation of wastelands by plantation drives, generating environmental awareness, tree adoption campaigns have been some of the events we have focussed on. The construction of a vertical garden in the arena of Botany Department is on the list of forthcoming activities of the club. GWC set an example of conducting a quintessential festival on 29th February, 2020 which was unprecedented as there was null wastage of resources. The funds raised during the festival were contributed to the charity.

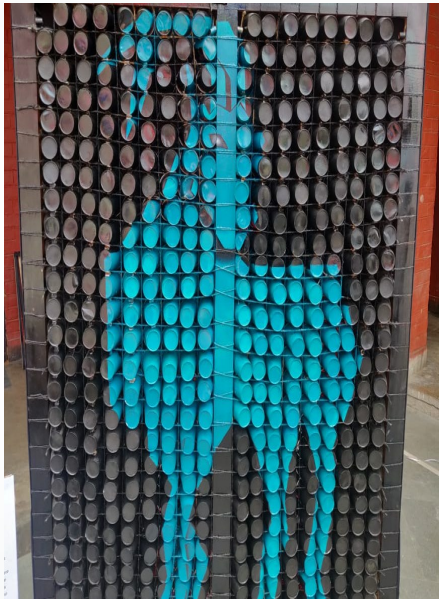
