DEPARTMENT OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND SPORTS

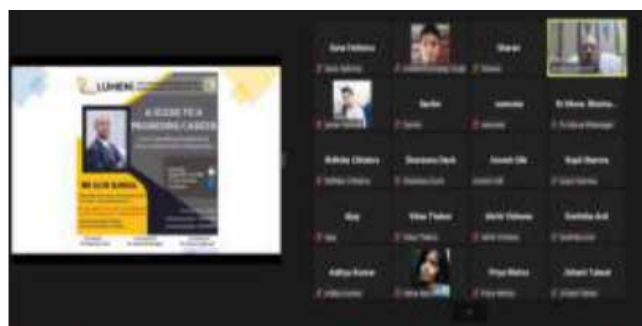
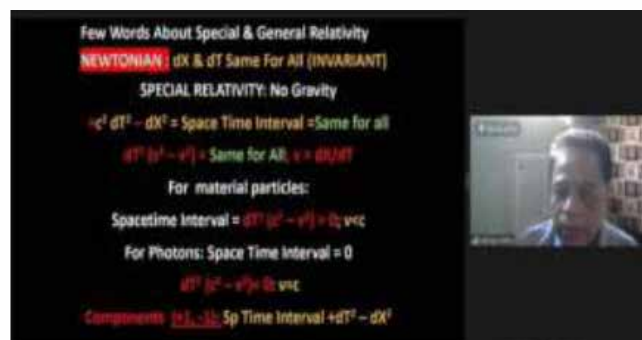

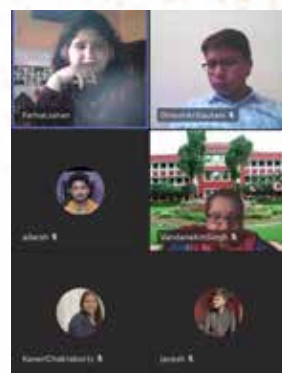


DEPARTMENT OF ZOOLOGY

राष्ट्रीय संगोष्ठी : 'आजादी के 75 साल, सुशासन का स्वप्न और 2047 का भारत'

भारतीय सामाजिक विज्ञान अनुसंधान परिषद, शिक्षा मंत्रालय एवं हंसराज कॉलेज के संयुक्त तत्वावधान में 'आजादी का अमृत महोत्सव' के उपलक्ष्य में दो दिवसीय राष्ट्रीय संगोष्ठी का आयोजन किया गया। 'आजादी के 75 साल, सुशासन का स्वप्न और 2047 का भारत' विषय पर 25-26 दिसंबर को आयोजित होने वाली उक्त संगोष्ठी के उद्घाटन सत्र में प्रो. रमा, डॉ. अनिर्बान गांगुली, श्री अनंत विजय एवं प्रो. रजनी अब्बी ने अपने विचार व्यक्त किए। कार्यक्रम के प्रारंभ में उपस्थित वक्ताओं ने दोनों भारत-रत्न पूर्व प्रधानमंत्री अटल बिहारी वाजपेयी एवं महान शिक्षाविद् महामना पंडित मदन मोहन मालवीय जी का उनकी जयंती पर स्मरण किया।

इस अवसर पर डॉ. श्यामा प्रसाद मुखर्जी शोध प्रतिष्ठान के मानद निदेशक एवं राष्ट्रवादी विद्वान डॉ. अनिर्बान गांगुली ने आजादी के बाद की विभिन्न सरकारों और वर्तमान नेतृत्व की सोच को सामने रखते हुए इस दौर को भारत के आत्म-गौरव, आत्म-सम्मान एवं स्वाभिमान के उत्कर्ष-काल के रूप में रेखांकित किया। उन्होंने स्वाधीन भारत में हुई ऐतिहासिक भूलों का जिक्र करते हुए वर्तमान समय में उसे ठीक किए जाने की प्रक्रिया और शासन की सोच को भी विस्तार से सामने रखा। उपस्थित वक्ताओं का स्वागत करते हुए हंसराज कॉलेज की प्राचार्या प्रो. रमा ने हंसराज कॉलेज की गौरवमयी परंपरा और राष्ट्र-निर्माण में यहाँ के पूर्व विद्यार्थियों के योगदान को रेखांकित करते हुए उपस्थित विद्यार्थियों एवं शोधार्थियों से देश के प्रति अपने दायित्व का निर्वहण करने का आह्वान किया। साथ ही, वर्तमान शासन और नेतृत्व के साहसिक, दूरदर्शी एवं परिवर्तनकारी कदमों की सराहना की।

दिल्ली विश्वविद्यालय के प्रॉक्टर प्रो. रजनी अब्बी ने कहा कि भारत एक मात्र ऐसा देश है जहाँ सुशासन की विशिष्ट परंपरा रही है। इन 75 वर्षों में कुछ चूक अवश्य हुई है लेकिन हमारी उपलब्धियाँ गर्व करने लायक हैं। दैनिक जागरण के एसोसिएट संपादक श्री अनंत विजय ने कहा कि इस देश के इतिहास के संबंध में कई भ्रांतियाँ संस्थागत तरीके से पैदा की गईं और उसी का प्रचार-प्रसार किया गया। अब आवश्यकता इस बात की है कि आज की पीढ़ी औपनिवेशिक सोच से बाहर निकले और इतिहास का तार्किक विश्लेषण करे। उद्घाटन सत्र का संचालन संगोष्ठी के समन्वयक डॉ. विजय कुमार मिश्र ने किया जबकि धन्यवाद ज्ञापन हिंदी विभाग के सहायक प्रोफेसर डॉ. नृत्य गोपाल शर्मा ने किया।

संगोष्ठी के एक अन्य महत्वपूर्ण सत्र में बिहार लोक सेवा आयोग के सदस्य प्रो. अरुण भगत ने सुशासन की अवधारणा और उसके मूलभूत बिंदुओं पर विस्तारपूर्वक अपनी बातें रखीं। उन्होंने भारत में शासन की परंपरा और उसके विविध आयामों के संदर्भ में सुशासन के वर्तमान संदर्भों का भी उल्लेख किया।



उन्होंने स्वाधीन भारत में शासन और लोकतंत्र से जुड़े विविध घटनाओं का जिक्र करते हुए प्रतिपादित किया कि शासन का वर्तमान स्वरूप और नेतृत्व हमें इस बात के लिए आश्चर्य करता है कि आने वाले समय में भारत अपने विश्व गुरु की प्रतिष्ठा को पुनः प्राप्त करने में सफल होगा। वहीं स्वाधीन भारत में सुशासन के आर्थिक पक्षों पर अपने मतव्य रखते हुए आर्थिक विशेषज्ञ गोपाल कृष्ण अग्रवाल जी ने भारत में आर्थिक क्षेत्र में होनी वाली प्रगति और विविध सरकारी योजनाओं के महत्व एवं उसके पीछे की दृष्टि को सामने रखा। उन्होंने सरकार द्वारा चलाई जा रही आर्थिक योजनाओं से आम लोगों के जीवन में हो रहे परिवर्तनों की ओर इशारा करते हुए कहा कि वर्तमान शासन और नेतृत्व देश की आर्थिक प्रगति के लिए अनेक मोर्चों पर संतुलित ढंग से आगे बढ़ रहा है। उन्होंने कहा भारत तेजी से विश्व की बड़ी आर्थिक शक्ति के रूप में अपना स्थान बनता जा रहा है।

संगोष्ठी के दूसरे दिन 'शासन की वर्तमान दिशा और भारत का भवितव्य' विषय पर अपनी बात रखते हुए डीडी न्यूज के वरिष्ठ सलाहकार संपादक अशोक श्रीवास्तव ने कहा कि वर्तमान सरकार ने अपने इतिहास, अपनी संस्कृति से जुड़े विषयों पर जिस तत्परता और गंभीरता के साथ कार्य किया है वह अत्यंत ही सराहनीय है। आकाशवाणी के सहायक निदेशक श्री जैनेंद्र सिंह ने कहा कि वर्तमान परिस्थितियों में सबसे अधिक जरूरत समाज जागरण की है और प्रधानमंत्री मंत्री द्वारा प्रसारित मन की बात कार्यक्रम कोई राजनीतिक कार्यक्रम न होकर जन जागरण का ही एक अनूठा प्रयास है।

समापन सत्र में जवाहर लाल नेहरू विश्वविद्यालय के डॉ. लोकेश ज़िंदल ने कहा कि हम देश से लेते बहुत हैं किन्तु जब देने का समय आता है तब हम अपने दायित्व से पीछे भागने लगते हैं, यह स्थिति ठीक नहीं है। राष्ट्रवादी विचारक एवं दिल्ली विश्वविद्यालय के राजनीति विज्ञान विभाग के अध्यक्ष प्रो. संगीत कुमार रागी ने कहा कि भारत ज्ञान में रत रहने वाला देश है, निरंतर अन्वेषण और अनुसंधान ही इसका स्वभाव रहा है, भारत की परंपरा सर्वे भवन्तु सुखिनः के सिद्धांत पर आधारित रही है। वहीं विश्वविद्यालय अनुदान आयोग की सदस्य एवं शिक्षाविद् प्रो. सुषमा यादव ने कहा कि यह वह समय है जब हमें अपनी अस्मिता को भाषाई अस्मिता से जोड़कर देखना होगा, आजादी की जगह स्वाधीनता जैसे शब्द कहीं अधिक श्रेयस्कर हैं। उन्होंने जोर देकर कहा कि भारत आज जिस रास्ते पर चल रहा है वह आश्चर्य करने वाला है। इसके साथ ही संगोष्ठी में अनेक गणमान्य विशेषज्ञ वक्ताओं ने संबंधित विषय पर अपने वक्तव्य दिए, अनेक शोध आलेख भी प्रस्तुत किए गए। उक्त संगोष्ठी का आयोजन स्वाधीन भारत की अब तक की यात्रा और भावी रणनीति पर संवाद की दृष्टि से किया गया। संगोष्ठी में 200 से अधिक प्राध्यापकों, शोधार्थियों एवं विद्यार्थियों ने सहभागिता की। अनेक प्राध्यापकों एवं शोधार्थियों ने उक्त विषय पर अपने आलेख प्रस्तुत किए। दो दिन की यह संगोष्ठी अत्यंत ही सफल रही, जिसका मीडिया में भी व्यापक कवरेज हुआ। समापन सत्र में इस संगोष्ठी में भाग लेने वाले सहभागियों को प्रमाण-पत्र भी वितरित किए गए।

आजादी का अमृत महोत्सव काव्य गोष्ठी

9 मार्च 2022 को दिल्ली विश्वविद्यालय के हंसराज कॉलेज के सभागार में 'आजादी का अमृत महोत्सव' के उपलक्ष्य में परिचर्चा एवं काव्य गोष्ठी का आयोजन किया गया। केंद्रीय हिंदी संस्थान एवं हंसराज कॉलेज के संयुक्त तत्वावधान में आयोजित राष्ट्रीय चेतना के कवि चंद्रकांत भारद्वाज स्मृति इस कार्यक्रम के प्रथम सत्र में 'भारतीय स्वाधीनता आन्दोलन और हिंदी कविता' विषयक परिचर्चा का आयोजन किया गया। इस परिचर्चा में हंसराज कॉलेज की प्राचार्या प्रो. रमा, साहित्य अकादमी के पूर्व उप सचिव ब्रजेन्द्र त्रिपाठी, वरिष्ठ लेखिका संतोष खन्ना, केन्द्रीय हिंदी संस्थान की निदेशिका प्रो. बीना शर्मा एवं केन्द्रीय हिंदी शिक्षण मंडल के उपाध्यक्ष श्री अनिल जोशी ने अपने विचार व्यक्त किए।

प्रो. रमा में स्वाधीनता आन्दोलन के दौरान महात्मा गाँधी सहित दूसरे राष्ट्रीय नेताओं के हिंदी के विकास में योगदान की चर्चा करते हुए कहा कि आज समय आ गया है जब हिंदी को राष्ट्रभाषा के रूप में संविधान में मान्यता मिले। उन्होंने आजादी के आन्दोलन में हिंदी लेखकों, पत्रकारों, नाट्यकर्मियों आदि के योगदान को रेखांकित किया।

इस अवसर पर श्री ब्रजेन्द्र त्रिपाठी ने 1857 की स्वाधीनता आन्दोलन और उससे पहले से ही राष्ट्रीय चेतना के विकास में हिंदी कवियों के योगदान को रेखांकित करते हुए इससे सम्बंधित पूरे ऐतिहासिक परिप्रेक्ष्य को विस्तारपूर्वक सामने रखा। उन्होंने मैथिली शरण गुप्त, शुभद्रा कुमारी चौहान, माखनलाल चतुर्वेदी आदि की काव्य पंक्तियों को उद्धृत करते हुए स्वाधीनता आन्दोलन के विकास और राष्ट्रीयता की भावना के प्रसार में हिंदी कवियों की भूमिका को बेहद महत्वपूर्ण माना।

वरिष्ठ लेखिका संतोष खन्ना ने आजादी के आन्दोलन में विभिन्न नारों और काव्य पंक्तियों से बने वातावरण को सामने रखते हुए हिंदी साहित्यकारों के अवदान का स्मरण करते हुए कहा कि आजादी के आन्दोलन में जितना योगदान हिंदी के कवियों का था उतना शायद ही किसी और का। यही कारण है कि गैर हिंदी भाषी नेताओं ने भी हिंदी की महत्ता को स्वीकार करते हुए इसे आजादी के आन्दोलन जोड़ने की कोशिश की और हिंदी के प्रचार-प्रसार का प्रयास किया। उन्होंने जयशंकर प्रसाद, बाल कृष्णा शर्मा नवीन आदि की कविताओं का उल्लेख करते हुए हिंदी कविता और राष्ट्रीय चेतना के विकास के व्यापक पहलुओं पर अपने विचार व्यक्त किए।

कार्यक्रम की अध्यक्षता कर रही केन्द्रीय हिंदी संस्थान की निदेशिका प्रो. बीना शर्मा ने बुंदेलों हर बोलों के मुंह हमने सूनी कहानी थी, मुझे तोड़ लेना



वनमाली, उस पथ पर देना तुम फेंक, हिमाद्री तुंग शृंग से प्रबुद्ध शुद्ध भारती जैसी अनेक कविताओं का उल्लेख करते हुए राष्ट्रीय स्वाधीनता आन्दोलन के विकास में योगदान देने वाले हिंदी कवियों का स्मरण किया और इस बात को रेखांकित किया कि उनके अवदान से मिली आजादी की रक्षा का दायित्व युवाओं पर है। उन्होंने विद्यार्थियों से राष्ट्र निर्माण में अपना योगदान देने का आह्वान भी किया।

परिचर्चा सत्र का संचालन कर रहे डॉ. विजय कुमार मिश्र ने चन्द्रकांत भारद्वाज के व्यक्तित्व एवं कृतित्व पर प्रकाश डालते हुए विषय का प्रवर्तन किया और आजादी के अमृत महोत्सव के उपलक्ष्य में आयोजित इस कार्यक्रम के औचित्य और उसकी सार्थकता पर प्रकाश डाला।

The visually impaired were granted access to the Braille Library. The college provided Laptops, Angel Recording Machines, Braille Book, and Book Scanning facilities for all PWD students.

The Library is regarded as the heart of any institution. Our College Library has a collection of more than 138959 books and around 9314 Book Bank collection.

More than 1092 volumes of books were added during the session 2021-22. The library spent 11.8 lakh+ rupees for procuring books, journals and magazines.

The library subscribed to N-LIST, an initiative of the Govt. Of India, which provides access to 6,000+ Journals, 1,99,500+ e-books and 6,00,000 e-books through NDL.

Our library also initiated DELNET service for promoting resource-sharing and to coordinate effort for collection development, followed by the subscription to Kibo Xs multilingual scanning and reading device for the enabling unit.

Digital Entry Register device was introduced to record the attendance of students accompanied by a subscription to 'Sugamya Pustakalaya' database for making books accessible to visually impaired individuals or to any person with any other print impairment.

The hostel sports tournament has also started, with cricket matches being played between the teams from all three years.

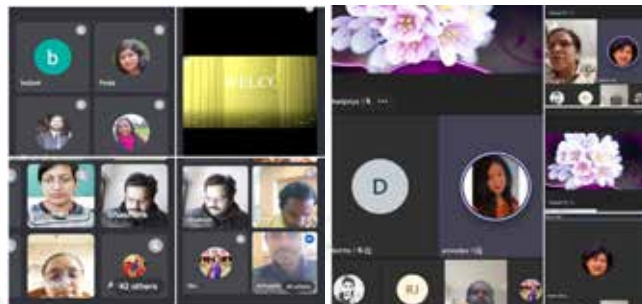
Football is also a commonly played sport among the hostel mates, alongwith volleyball and badminton.

Enactus Hansraj is a student-run international organization focusing on social entrepreneurship, we organized a myriad of social welfare activities in the year 2021-22.

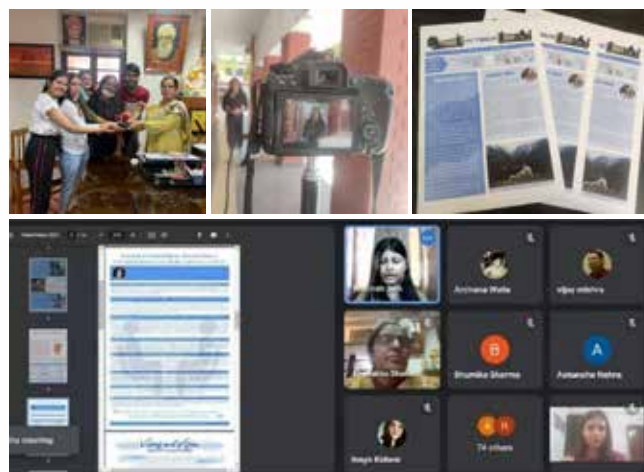

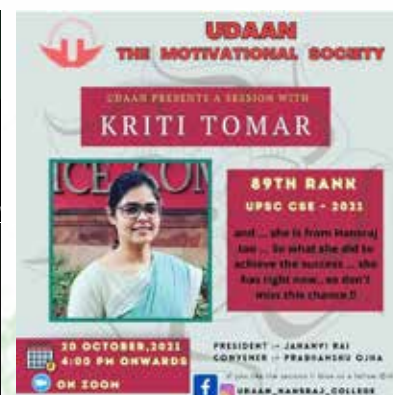
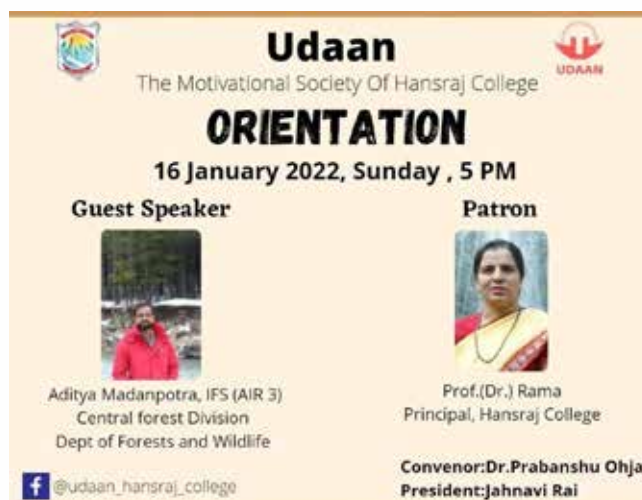
