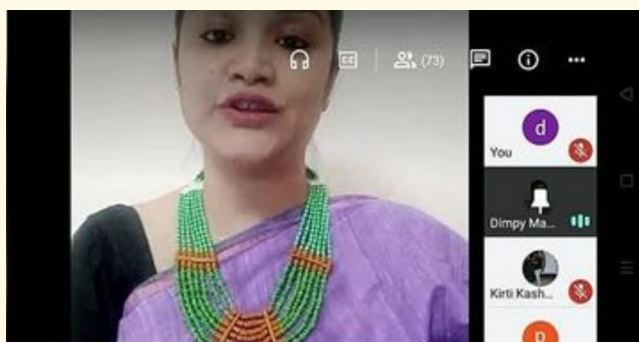


## DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY

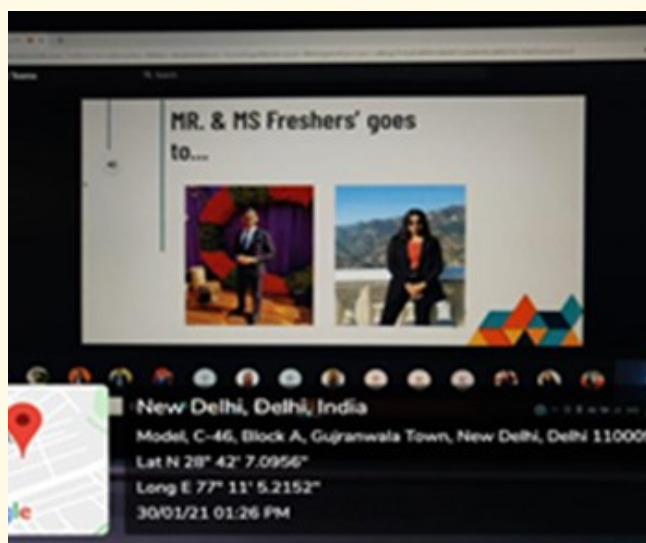
# Departmental Reports

The academic session 2020-21 put demanded organizing online events and an insightful webinar on “Essentials of Writing High-Quality Paper: A view from an Editor and Reviewer” was organized on 28th August 2020 in collaboration with MHRFDC, Hansraj College where Dr. Sudhir Rana from FIIB was the resource person.

This was followed by a workshop on “Understanding IND-AS Compliant Financial Statement” organized on 4th September 2020 taken by CA Alok Kumar Garg. A guest lecture on the “Recent trends in HR” was also organized on 10th October, delivered by Dr. Shweta Jha of Apeejay School of Management among other events organized on the same date. For the first time, a case study competition “Caselytical 20” and an Article Writing Competition were organized in the month of October-November, the best entries of which will be published in the annual magazine DeFacto’21. 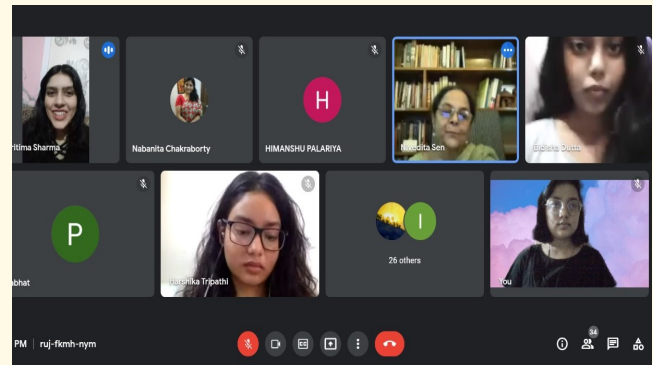

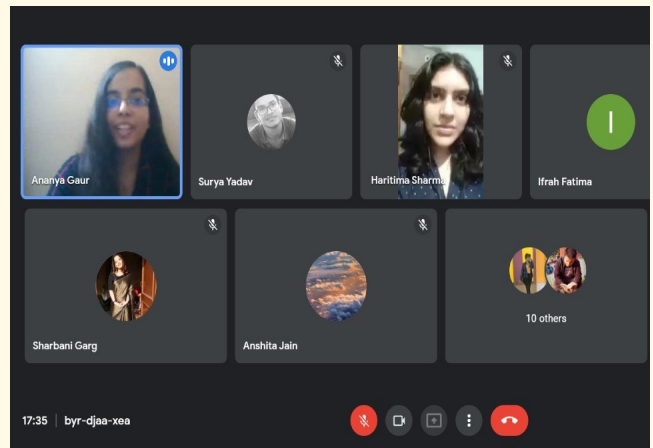


A society targeted at continually revitalizing the spirit of learning, The English Society of Hansraj College works for the holistic development of the students- in and outside the department.

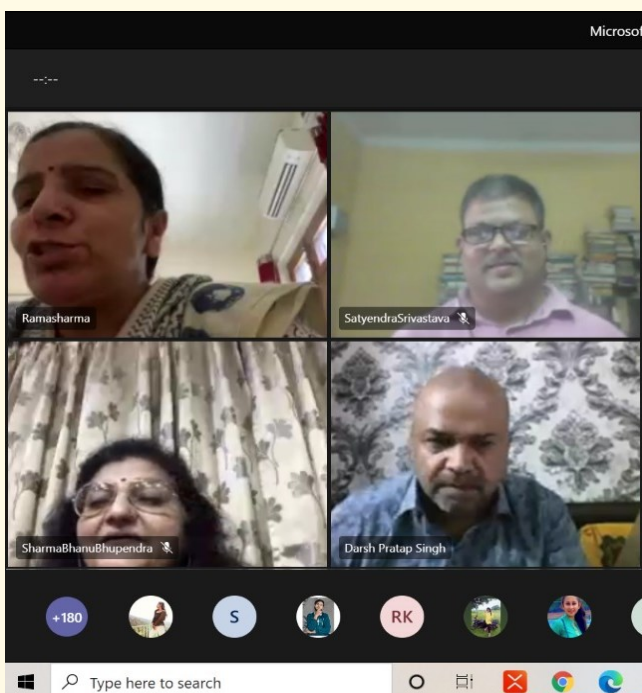

## DEPARTMENT OF PHYSICS & ELECTRONICS

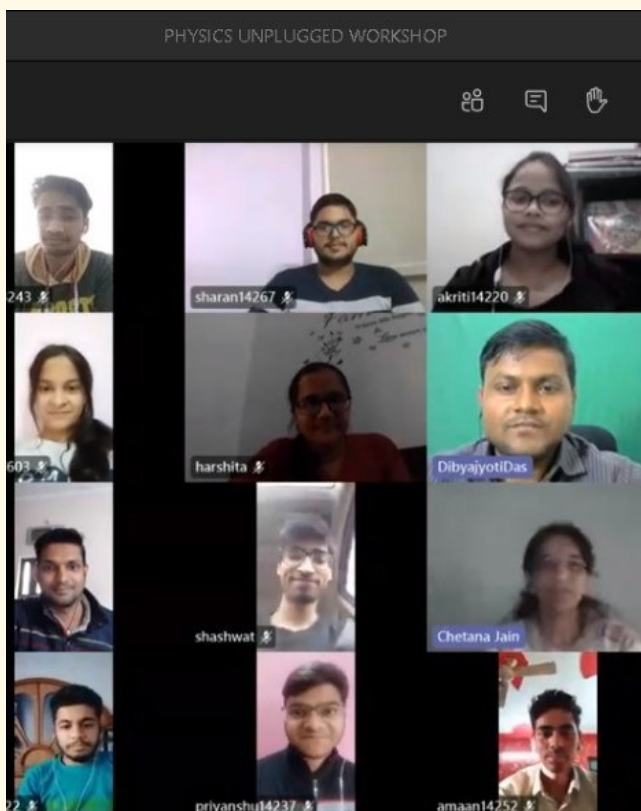
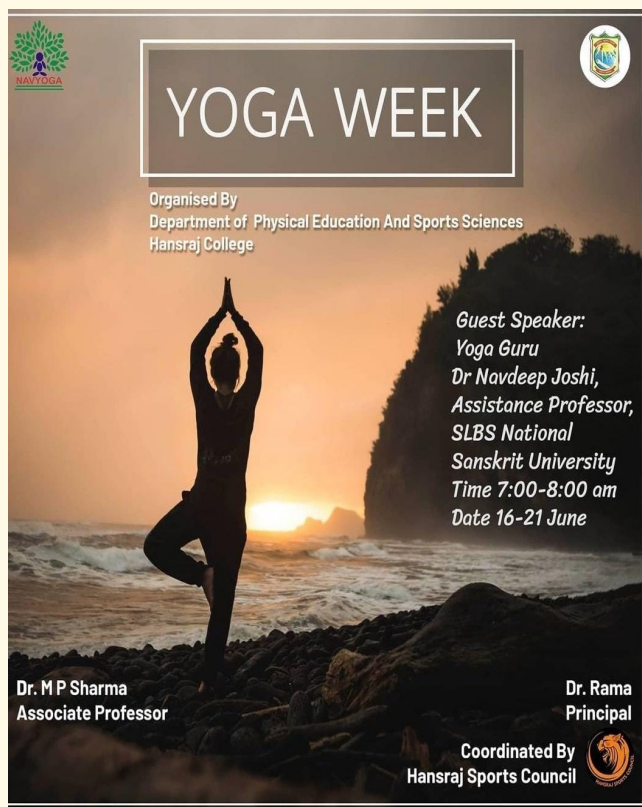

## DEPARTMENT OF ZOOLOGY

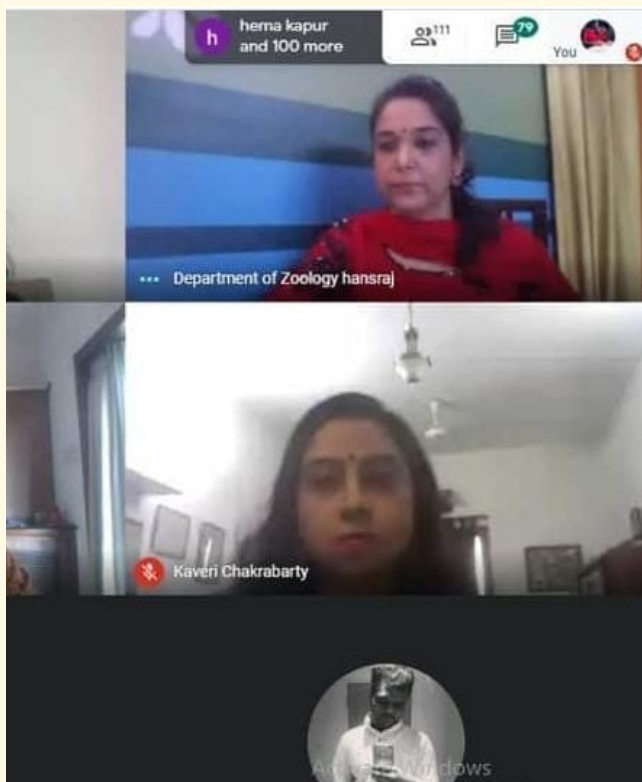

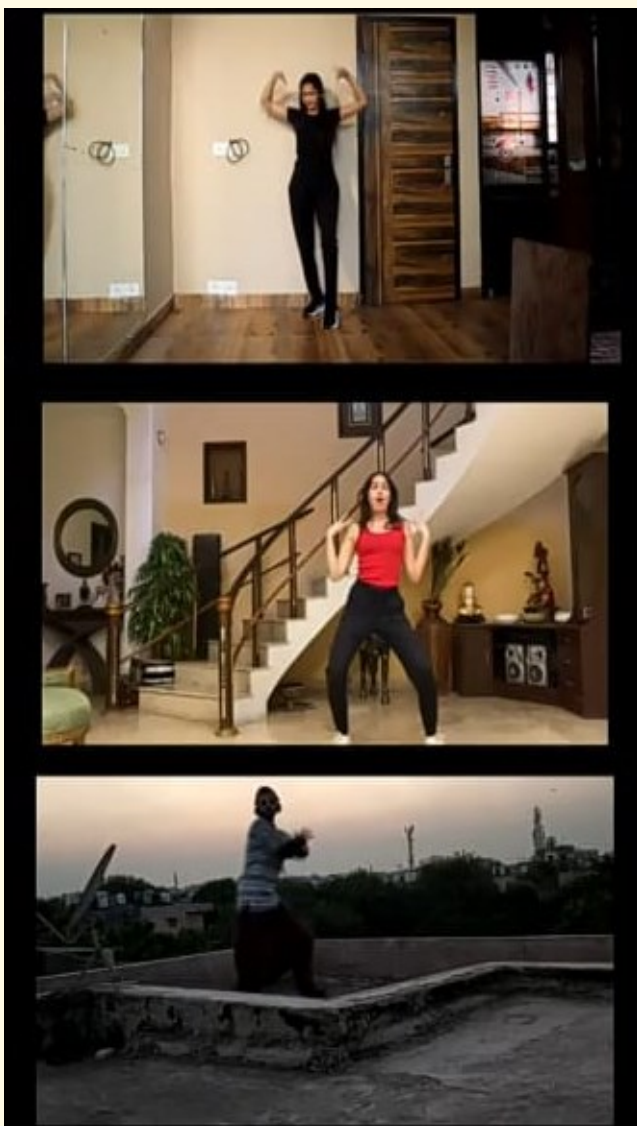
## SWARANJALI, MUSIC SOCIETY

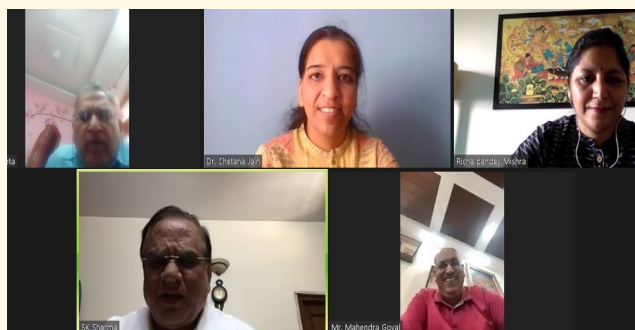

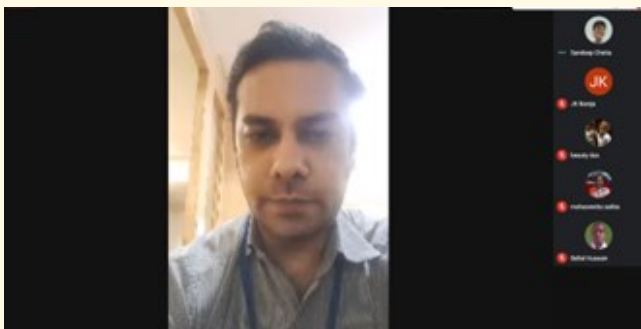

Other events included a Film Festival in collaboration with Vision HRC and GWC Hansraj, Eco-rangoli competition, article writing etc.

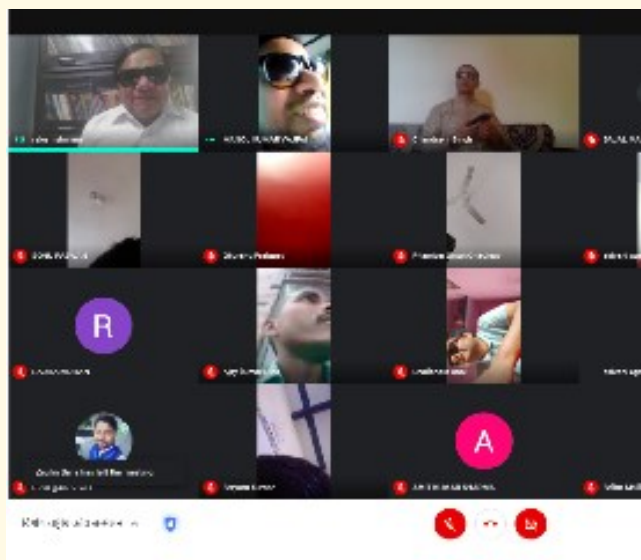




# Formal Entities

## ENABLING UNIT

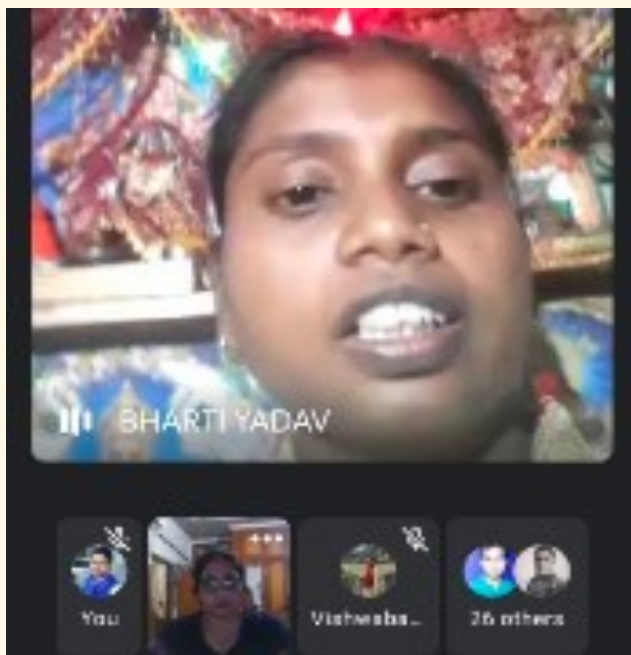

## SPIC MACAY

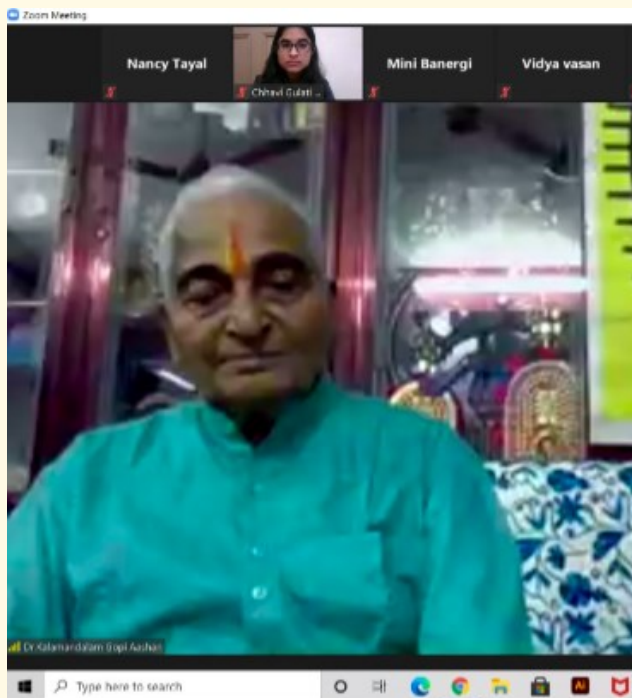

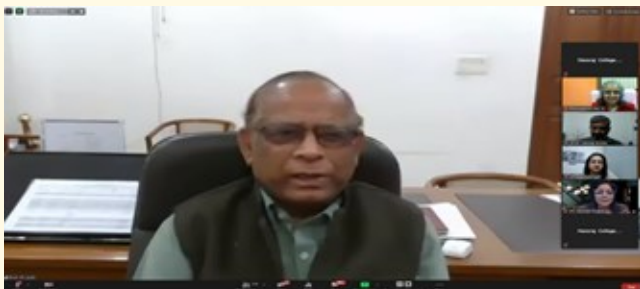

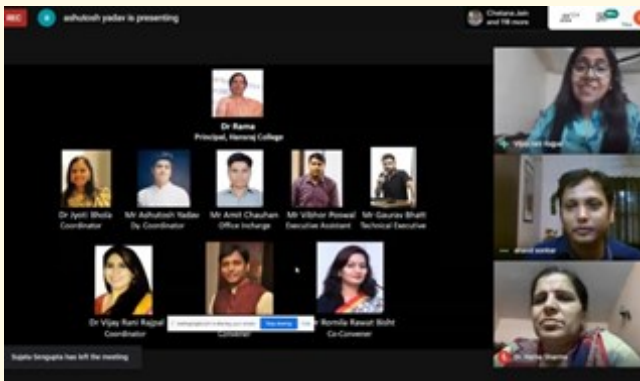


## MAHATMA HANSRAJ FACULTY DEVELOPMENT CENTRE

## E-CELL

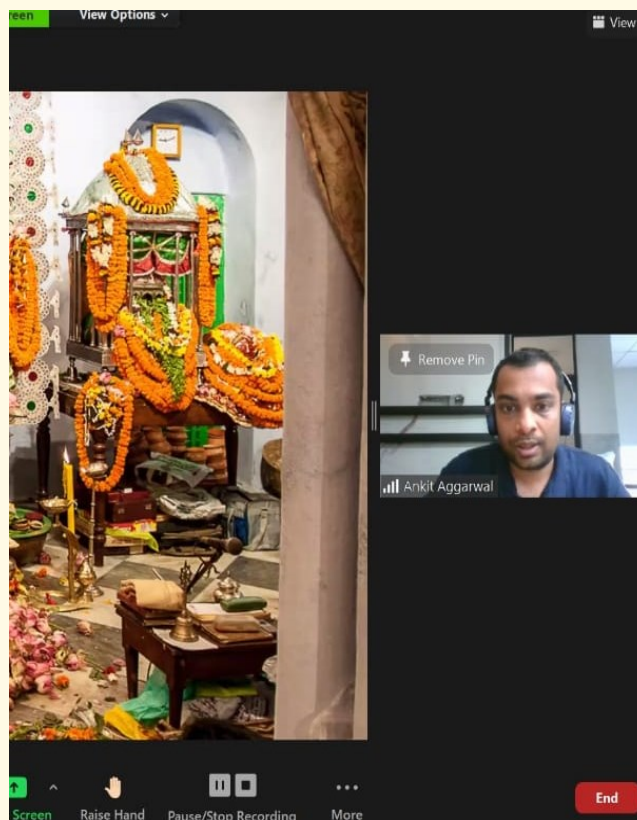
