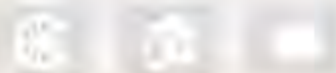

माननीया राज्यपाल, गोवा

श्रीमती मृदुला सिन्हा का जन्म १९४२ में बिहार के छपरा जिले में हुआ। इनकी प्रारंभिक एवं उच्च शिक्षा बिहार में ही हुई। इन्होंने लगभग डेढ़ दशक तक अध्यापन कार्य किया।

इन्होंने 'ज्यों मेहंदी के रंग', 'भरबास', 'नई देवयानी', 'सीता पुनि बोली', 'बतिशब', 'विजयनी' (उपन्यास), 'साकारकार', 'एक दिये की झीवाली', 'स्पर्श की तासीर', 'अपना जीवन' (कहानी संग्रह), 'राजपथ' (जीवनी), 'आईने के सामने', 'मानवी के नाते', 'पुरान के बज्जे', 'बिहार की लोककथाएं', 'मात्र देह नहीं है औरत', 'बिटिया है विशेष', 'नारी न कठपुतली न उड़नपरी' (लेख संग्रह) जैसी ५० से अधिक पुस्तकों का सृजन कर न केवल हिंदी साहित्य को समृद्ध किया बल्कि देश की स्थापित पत्रिकाओं में लगातार लेखों द्वारा आलोचना विधा में भी अपना योगदान दिया। इनकी कहानी और उपन्यासों पर फिल्मों और धारावाहिकों का निर्माण भी हुआ है जिनमें 'बत्तक', 'उधार का सूरज', 'ज्यों मेहंदी के रंग', 'खेल खेल में', 'एक भी रानी ऐसी भी' आदि प्रमुख हैं।



अपनी साहित्यिक उत्कृष्टता के लिए इन्हें उत्तर प्रदेश हिंदी संस्थान द्वारा 'साहित्य भूषण सम्मान', 'पं. दीनदयाल उपाध्याय सम्मान', बिश्न हिंदी समिति न्यूयार्क द्वारा 'विशिष्ट सम्मान', 'राष्ट्रीय शिखर सम्मान', 'कल्पतरु सम्मान', 'बोजस्विनी शिखर सम्मान' एवं 'साहित्य श्री सम्मान' आदि सम्मानों से विभूषित किया जा चुका है।

साहित्य के अतिरिक्त सामाजिक, राजनीतिक क्षेत्र में विभिन्न समितियों को सफलता पूर्वक निभाने के साथ ही आपने अनेक प्रशासकीय पदों पर कार्य करते हुए भी अपना विशेष योगदान दिया है, जिनमें राजभाषा समिति, गृह मंत्रालय तथा हिंदी सलाहकार समिति, इस्पात मंत्रालय की सबस्य के साथ ही केन्द्रीय समाज कल्याण बोर्ड की अध्यक्षता, दिल्ली महिला आयोग के सदस्य एवं रेलवे सलाहकार समिति, रेल मंत्रालय का सदस्य आदि शामिल हैं। आपने पांचवां स्तम्भ नामक सामाजिक पत्रिका के जरिये श्री महत्वपूर्ण योगदान दिया है। सम्प्रति आप गोवा की माननीया राज्यपाल के रूप में सुशोभित हैं।



श्री रंजन मुखर्जी

अतिरिक्त महानिदेशक, प्रसार भारती

श्री रंजन मुखर्जी भारतीय वायुसेना में एयर कोमोडोर रैंक के वरिष्ठ सैन्य अधिकारी हैं, बंगाल के एक जमींदार घराने में जन्म लेने वाले रंजन जी छात्र जीवन से ही बहुमुखी प्रतिभा के धनी रहे। शालीनता और अध्ययनशीलता के गुण उन्हें अपने पिता श्री चंद्रशेखर मुखर्जी एवं माता पार्वती से विरासत में मिले। बालक रंजन की प्रारम्भिक शिक्षा कोलकाता में ही हुई, आगे की स्कूली पढाई के लिए माता-पिता ने सैनिक स्कूल, पुरलिया को चुना। स्कूली पाठ्यक्रम पूरा होते ही उन्हें एन.डी.ए. की परीक्षा में चुन लिया गया परन्तु कुछ अपरिहार्य कारणों से वे एन.डी.ए. में शामिल नहीं हुए।

स्कूल की पढाई के पश्चात् वह आगे की पढाई कृषि में करना चाहते थे अतः उन्होंने बनारस हिन्दू विश्वविद्यालय से अध्ययन करने का निश्चय किया। १९८१ में तकनीकी कृषि विज्ञान से उन्होंने स्नातक और १९८३ में कृषि अर्थव्यवस्था में एम.ए. की उपाधि प्राप्त की। विद्यालयीय जीवन में ही उन्होंने बंगाली साहित्य के शरत चंद्र, टैगोर आदि मूर्धन्य साहित्यकारों का गहन अध्ययन कर लिया। विश्वविद्यालय की शिक्षा के दौरान गंगा स्वच्छता अभियान से जुड़कर व्यापक स्तर पर कार्य किया।

फुटबाल के तो जैसे रंजन जी दीवाने ही थे। १९७६ में स्कूल के लिए सुब्रतो फुटबाल खिला था, विश्वविद्यालय की फुटबाल टीम में भी उनका महत्वपूर्ण स्थान था। कॉलेज की पढाई के बाद रंजन जी ने 'टी टेस्टर' का रोचक पेशा अपनाया।



पैसा कमाने की भरपूर गुंजाइश के बाव भी उन्होंने ये पेशा चल्च ही छोड़ दिया। कुछ समय के लिए बैंक पीओ की भी नौकरी की, झुपीएससी के जरिए आपने एयरफ़ोर्स में कमीशन हासिल किया। एयरफ़ोर्स में आपकी सेवाओं एवं उपलब्धियों को देखते हुए २६ जनवरी २०१२ को राष्ट्रपति द्वारा 'विशिष्ट सेवा मेडल' से सम्मानित किया गया। इसी समय दिल्ली के उपराज्यपाल तेजिंदर खन्ना जी की नज़र आपकी कार्य क्षमता और कर्तव्यनिष्ठा पर पड़ी। उनके विशेष आग्रह पर आपने डेपुटेशन पर उपराज्यपाल के ओएसडी अर्थात् विशेष कार्याधिकारी के रूप में दिल्ली प्रशासन में महत्वपूर्ण योगदान दिया।

राष्ट्रमंडल खेलों के सफल आयोजन में आपकी प्रमुख भूमिका रही। तेजिंदर खन्ना जी के कार्यकाल पूरा होने के पश्चात् आप वापस एयरफ़ोर्स में चले गए, भारत सरकार के प्रस्ताव पर रंजन जी ने किसान चैनल की कमान संभाल ली आपके वक्त्र परिचय एवं कार्यकुशलता से एक साल के भीतर डीडी किसान चैनल जनता के बीच काफी लोकप्रिय हुआ।

किसान चैनल में कई प्रकार के गुणात्मक परिवर्तन का श्रेय प्राप्त करने के बाव ये डीडी उर्दू को संभालने के साथ-साथ दूरदर्शन की आय बढ़ाने के अभियान में प्रयासरत हैं।

- Academic Calendar & Modular Plans

IQAC proposed and initiated the process of designing and formulating department wise Academic Calendar and a College Academic Calendar. The Calendar is to broadly list out the major activities and their schedule at the department and college level. These include the academic activities, college festivals, society events, and also administrative tasks and their respective deadlines. IQAC also initiated the making of Modular Plans by each faculty member for efficient follow up of their course syllabus.

- Feedback system

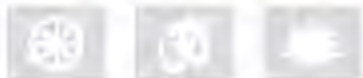

The Placement Cell of Hansraj College has striven to provide its students with an atmosphere that promotes growth and development in every domain. Expressing this very spirit of the cell, numerous seminars and sessions were held during the academic year of 2016-2017 with students to ensure an all-round experience for our budding game changers.

Socially oriented programs with a strong backing of business included programs such as Gandhi Fellowship, Teach For India, Young India Fellowship and Data Fellowship by Social Cops were undertaken. Such opportunities enabled students to get sensitized to social issues and give back to the society while learning an array of new skills.

Nine students were placed in Dream Companies with packages over 10 Lakhs while a whopping 30 were swooped in by Tier 2 companies including RSA Analytics, Boston Consultancy Group and United Airlines. The recruitment drive has met with 146 offers during the current academic year with various companies with pending processes. The average package for placements stood around 4.6 lakhs per student. Various visits by top notch article-ship programs by PwC, Ernst and Young, Mazars etc. resulted in selection of 18 students for the same.

The college also boasts of an active internship Cell with over 100 students placed by the same. Some of our recruiters for Internships included IDBI Bank, Panasonic, Encyclopedia Britannica etc. A successful internship fair was also organised with saw a participation of over 40 companies and saw an attendance of 1,500 students for the same.

Placement cell is driven by the ideology of creating a conducive environment for placements and skill enhancement of students by creating a variety of growth centered avenues.
