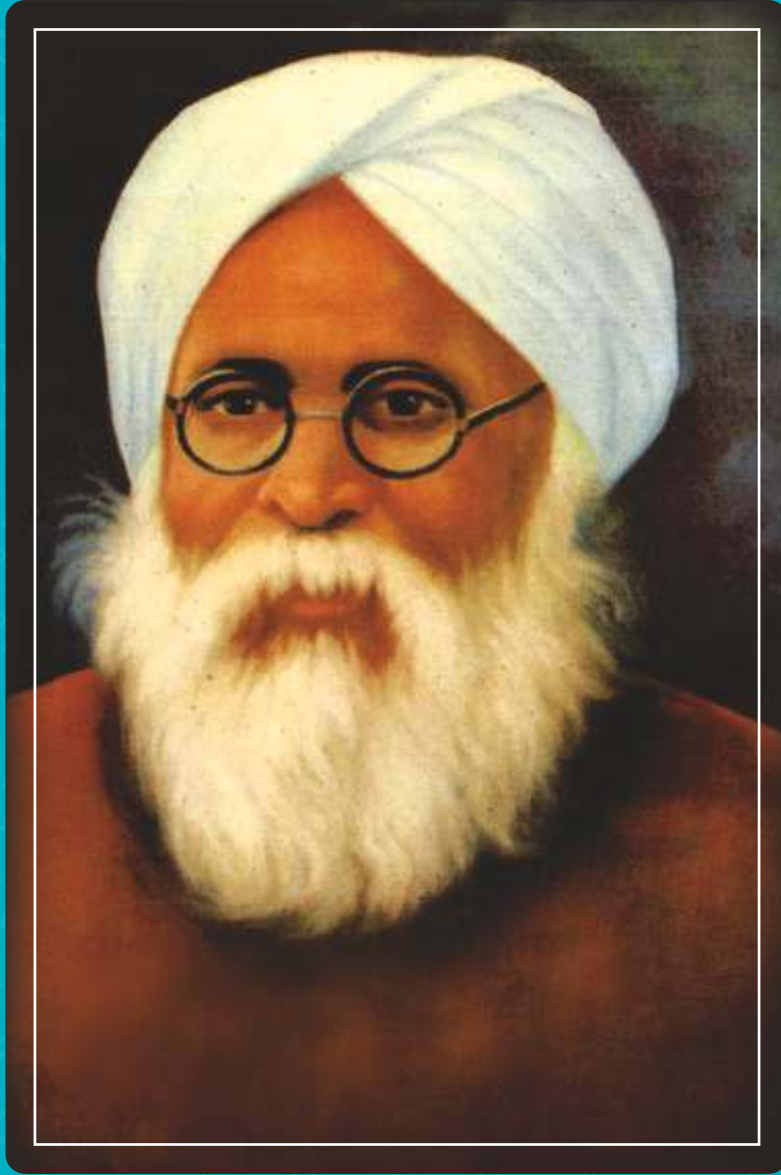

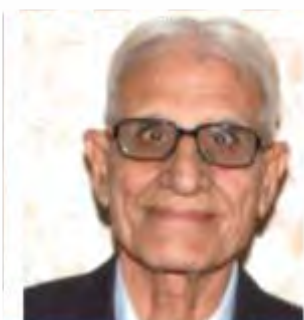

### Col. Rajyavardhan Singh Rathore

Minister of State (Independent Charge) for Youth Affairs and Sports  
Minister of State for Information and Broadcasting, Govt. of India

Shri Rajyavardhan Singh Rathore was born in Jaisalmer, Rajasthan to Dr. Gayatri Rathore and Colonel Lakshman Singh Rathore (retd) on 29th January, 1970. He is an Indian politician and a former professional shooter. He is a graduate of the 77th Course of the National Defence Academy. He was later commissioned in the 9th Grenadiers (Mewar) Regiment.

Col. Rajyavardhan Rathore (Retd.) served in army for 23 years since 1990. As part of his career in the Indian Army, he served in Jammu and Kashmir, where he participated in counter-terrorist operations. In 2013, Col Rajyavardhan Rathore took voluntary retirement from military to serve the nation as people's representative and joined the Bhartiya Janta Party.

As a shooter, he represented the country in the double trap event at the 2004 Olympic Games, winning a silver medal. He has also won 25 international medals at various other championships including the Commonwealth and the Asian Games. The Colonel was also awarded the prestigious Padma Shri in 2005.

He was elected as a Member of Parliament in the 2014 Lok Sabha election from the Jaipur Rural Constituency. In November 2014, was made the Minister of State for Information and Broadcasting, a post he served till 2017. Seeing his past career and passion for sports, Col. Rathore was appointed as a Cabinet Minister with independent charge for the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports in 2017.





### Sh. Ashok Kumar Poddar

Chief Vigilance Officer, RITES, Ministry of Railways Govt. of India



Sri Ashok Kumar Poddar studied in Hansraj College, University of Delhi from 1978 to 1983. He achieved the distinction of top rank in Post Graduation in History in 1983. In fact, he scored 69% which broke all previous records. In view of his achievements, he was awarded VKRV Rao Gold Medal as well as Lala Ram Mohan prize by the University of Delhi. He was also selected member of Academic Council of University of Delhi for the year 1983 – 1984.

He was lecturer in University of Delhi for three years before he qualified in Civil Services examination and was allocated Indian Postal Services in 1987. He worked specifically in the field of anti-corruption

measures & Vigilance matters. The security scam of 1992, also called Harshad Mehta scam was investigated by him. He worked as Chief Vigilance Officer in various organisations. At present, he is Chief Vigilance Officer, RITES, Ministry Of Railways. Keeping in view his contributions in preventive Vigilance, he was awarded Vigilance Excellence Award in 2014 and 2016. He was also honoured with Kalam Innovation In Governance Award in 2016 for his contribution in anti-corruption initiatives. He is also a member of the working group set up by Confederation of Indian Industries to explore methods of introducing transparency and integrity in private sector in India.

## विकास के चरण

He is a renowned professor in molecular biology from Department of Zoology, University of Delhi. He emphasised on the importance of an upcoming field which requires minimal infrastructure and resources and can lead to enormous findings by analysing the data. One of his interesting findings revealed that our gut micro biome determine our personality and can help us lead a healthy life. Afterwards, a hands-on training was given by his PhD students to sequence and analyse genomes of various organisms. They gave insights in the field of computational biology and its tools and software.

## प्रख्यात कवि कुँवर नारायण की कविताओं पर राष्ट्रीय संगोष्ठी

हंसराज कॉलेज के सभागार में 'समय मीमांसा' पत्रिका एवं हंसराज कॉलेज के संयुक्त तत्वावधान में कुँवर नारायण के 90वें जन्मदिन पर उनके व्यक्तित्व और कृतित्व को केंद्र में रखकर राष्ट्रीय संगोष्ठी का आयोजन किया गया। दो सत्रों में आयोजित इस कार्यक्रम के प्रथम-सत्र के प्रथम वक्ता अनंतविजय पालीवाल जी ने कहा कि -'कुँवर नारायण की कविताओं को लेकर हमेशा ये विवाद उठता रहा है कि वे अस्तित्ववादी हैं या मार्क्सवादी, जबकि कुँवर जी ने ऐसा कहीं माना नहीं है। अनंतविजय जी ने आगे रामविलास शर्मा, अशोक वाजपेयी, विष्णु खरे आदि आलोचकों के उद्धरण से अपनी बात स्पष्ट किया। अम्बेडकर विश्वविद्यालय से आए प्रो. सत्यकेतु सांकृत जी ने कुँवर नारायण को 'अतिशय बौद्धिकता' का कवि माना है। आगे वे 'आत्मजयी' और 'वाजश्रवा के बहाने' का उदाहरण देते हुए-जीवन-मृत्यु-मृत्यु-जीवन संघर्ष से जोड़कर अपने विचार व्यक्त किया। तीसरे वक्ता कवि -चिंतक असद जैदी ने कुँवर नारायण की कविताओं के संबंध में कहा कि -'कुँवर जी बिना किसी एथिक्स के, बिना किसी बुनियादी नैतिक धुरी के, जो कुछ भी अच्छा लगा, लेते रहे हैं, वे सर्वग्राही नहीं है, बल्कि एक नैतिक एकरूपता से अपनी कविताओं को रेखांकित करते रहे हैं।' इस सत्र की अध्यक्षता कर रहे पुरुषोत्तम अग्रवाल ने कुँवर नारायण को समकालीन दौर का ही नहीं बल्कि हिंदी कविता के इतिहास का प्रमुख कवि माना है, उन्होंने कहा कि-कुँवर जी की कविताएं हमारे भविष्य को प्रकाशित करती रहेंगी। आज के समय को पुरुषोत्तम जी ने 'आधुनिक मूल्यों के प्रत्यावर्तन' का समय कहा।

द्वितीय -सत्र में भारतीय ज्ञानपीठ के निदेशक लीलाधर मंडलोई जी ने कहा कि कुँवर जी का साहित्य लाउड नहीं है, उन्होंने कभी भी जोर-जोर से चिल्लाकर अपनी बात नहीं कही है यही उनकी रचनाओं और खासकर कविताओं की विशेषता है। बिना लाउडनेस के, बिना नफरत के अपनी बात

सहजता के साथ रखते हैं। हां चेतावनी और सावधान का स्वर कहीं -कहीं मुखर हुआ है। हंसराज कॉलेज के प्राध्यापक विजय कुमार मिश्र ने कुँवर जी की हाल में आई पुस्तक 'लेखक का सिनेमा' पर बोलते हुए कहा कि यह किताब एक लेखक की दृष्टि से, लेखक के द्वारा साहित्यिक दृष्टि से विश्व सिनेमा पर लिखी गयी महत्वपूर्ण किताब है। दूसरे सत्र के तीसरे वक्ता संवाद आईएस के निदेशक कुमार अजेय ने कवि कुँवर नारायण की भाषा और संवेदना पर बात करते हुए कहा कि जितना व्यापक संदर्भ होगा, उतना ही भाषा सरल होगी तथा सर्जनात्मक-चिंतन वृहत्तर होगा। उन्होंने कहा कि कुँवर जी की कविताएं बाहरी दुनिया की सैर कराती हुई हमारे अंतर्मन को झकझोरती है, बाहरी जगत के चिंतन द्वारा। प्रसिद्ध आलोचक और दिल्ली विश्वविद्यालय के प्रोफेसर गोपेश्वर सिंह ने 1960 के आलोचना-दशक पर बात करते हुए कुँवर जी को विवाद-मुक्त आलोचक और कवि माना। कविता में सम्प्रेषणीयता का जिक्र करते हुए-अंतिम सम्प्रेषण का कवि कुँवर नारायण को ही माना। इस सत्र की अध्यक्षता कर रहे कवि और कला चिंतक अशोक वाजपेयी ने कहा - 'कवि कुँवर नारायण की कविता और गद्य दोनों ही साफ़ -सुथरा है; यानि वे हिंदी के संभवतः सबसे अनाटकीय कवि और अनाटकीय आलोचक हैं। वो अपनी बात बिना किसी नाटकीयता से रखते हैं, बिल्कुल शांत और धीरोदात्त नायक हैं अपनी आवाज ऊंची उठाते ही नहीं हैं। इस मामले में वे अजातशत्रु कवि हैं। इस सत्र में धन्यवाद ज्ञापन राजकमल प्रकाशन से आये अलिंद महेश्वरी जी ने किया।

## पुस्तकालय

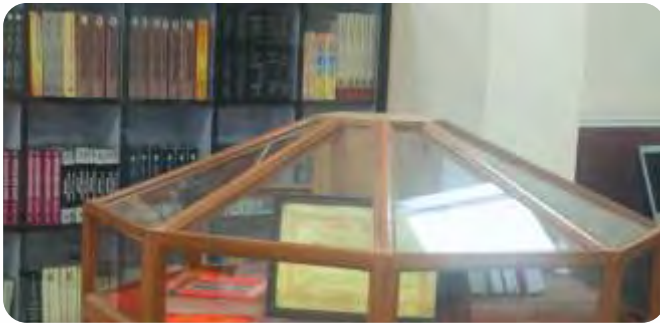

वर्ष 2017-18 में पुस्तकों एवं अन्य मदों पर 15,90,815 रुपये व्यय किये गये। 1430 पुस्तकें खरीदी गयीं तथा 52 पत्र-पत्रिकाएं मंगवाई गईं। इस वर्ष लगभग 1,45,000 पुस्तकें छात्रों, प्राध्यापकों एवं कर्मचारियों को निर्गमित की गईं। पुस्तकालय प्रातः 8 बजे से सायं 5 बजे तक खुला रहता है। शनिवार को पुस्तकालय प्रातः 9 बजे से सायं 4 बजे तक खुला रहता है। परीक्षा के समय तथा सभी कार्य दिवसों में पुस्तकालय रात्रि के 8 बजे तक खुला रहता है तथा अवकाश के दिनों में प्रातः 9 से सायं 4 बजे तक खोला जाता है।

पुस्तकालय को पूरी तरह वातानुकूलित कर दिया गया है। पुस्तकालय में छात्रों के लिये कम्प्यूटर तथा इंटरनेट की सुविधा भी उपलब्ध है। नई तकनीक आर. एफ. आय. डी.(R.F.I.D.) के अन्तर्गत

पुस्तकालय का डिजिटलीकरण कर दिया गया है। इस प्रणाली के अन्तर्गत पुस्तकालय के सदस्य स्वयं कियोस्क(Kiosk) तथा ड्रॉप्बॉक्स(Dropbox) की मदद से पुस्तकें निर्गमित तथा वापिस कर सकते हैं।

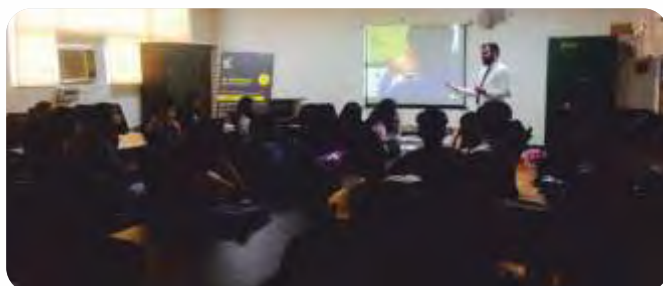
## PLACEMENT CELL

The placement cell of Hansraj college has been successfully providing students with employment opportunities, acting as a gateway to the corporate world.

We began the academic session with a seminar in collaboration with Ernst and young which focused on the skills of CV building and interview preparation. We also organized an interactive workshop for second-year students on how to begin preparing for interviews. All these seminars have evidently been very helpful to students over the past years in building their personal skill set. Moreover, we successfully conducted the process of 90\* companies, on and off campus, having delivered offer letters to 131\* students in total.

Till date, the highest package that has been offered is by D.E. Shaw & Co., of INR 1700000\*. We have the process of two other profiles by D.E. Shaw & Co. ongoing, which provides students with offers of INR 1900000\* in total. Out of the 90 companies that we have had, 5 have offered writing opportunities to our students. Well-reputed companies like McKinsey Knowledge Center, Bain Capability Center, Boston Consulting Group, Deloitte Consulting, Ernst & Young, D.E. Shaw and United Airlines have been visiting our campus for past several years.

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Hansraj College was formally established in August 2015 with the objective to design, implement, monitor, review and update the Quality Policy of the college. Ever since its inception, the Cell has been working dedicatedly to channelize and catalyze the efforts of the stakeholders of the institution to bring about a visible change in the academic and administrative culture of the institution. It is a matter of pride for the members of the Cell to acknowledge that the efforts of the IQAC have indeed left a positive impact on the work culture and have streamlined the procedural modalities of the college, thereby improving its overall efficiency and management.

Due to the unremitting efforts of IQAC along with administration and all departments, the college was able to add another feather in the cap by securing the overall score of 3.62, grade A+ in NAAC assessment.

For the academic session 2017-18, it worked in close association with the academic fraternity to discuss and formulate a plan of action which aims to strive for academic excellence. It also shouldered the responsibility to follow up on the successful implementation and monitoring of the academic enrichment activities undertaken by respective departments. It ensured that the quality of teaching-learning processes is not compromised at any stage. Through its efficient guidance and the resources at its disposal, the IQAC served as a facilitator in improvising various aspects of academic and administrative procedures in college. It achieved so by:



- designing Quality parameters and Key Performance Indicators for every course for every department. This was followed by monitoring the status of KPIs and taking corrective actions wherever required.
- conducting regular Session Audits of each department.
- encouraging the faculty to organize and take part in Faculty Development Programs.

- approving the purchase of Teaching Aid software and tools and also recommending the setting up of ICT facilities for all departments.

It functioned as a common link between various stakeholders by providing channels of feedback about the quality of curriculum delivery, the limitations faced and invited proposals for improvement



The feedback was thoroughly analyzed by the IQAC and appropriate recommendations were made to the Principal.

IQAC is an integral part of the Quality Policy review mechanism. Quality policies are periodically reviewed and updated by the Principal and the IQAC team for any changes which are felt to be necessary and a need of the hour. The process is made inclusive and holistic by discussing the proposed changes with the faculty members and incorporating their valuable inputs and suggestions.

The presence of a body like IQAC has promoted a culture of participative management.

### ENRICHMENT PROGRAM

IQAC has been constantly working for enrichment of faculty members as well as non teaching staff. IQAC organized a workshop with Department of Botany on "Computer proficiency in day-to-day work and dealings in work place and public life" for non teaching staff on 6th July, 2017.

### MENTORSHIP DAY

The importance of a healthy Student-Teacher interaction cannot be underemphasized. A teacher's role in a student's life goes beyond the exchange of knowledge within the walls of the classroom. As a guide, a mentor and a facilitator, a teacher can help a student become a successful individual and also help him/her face the challenges of college life.

The IQAC took the initiative to strengthen this student-teacher bond by organizing a Mentorship day in the College on 30th July, 2017. It was a novel effort to reach out to the students and discuss the issues faced by them concerning studies, their career, their passions etc.





The Initiative received a positive feedback and was appreciated by both the teachers and students.

### INTERNSHIP FAIR

The College lays great emphasis on providing a platform to students where they can interact with industry experts, professionals from the corporate arena, startups, non-profit organizations and government employers.

In view of the above, IQAC played a crucial role in the conduct of the Internship Fair 2018 organized by the Placement Cell and Neenv - the HRD Cell. It came up with the proposal to organize the fair and proactively followed up the conduct of the fair. It was organized on 9th February. It saw participation from close to 50 companies and was a huge success among students and the companies which visited the campus for recruiting interns.

### ACADEMIC CALENDER & MODULAR PLANS

Like previous year, IQAC undertook the process of designing and formulating department wise Academic Calendar and a college Academic Calendar. The calendar is to broadly list out the major activities and their schedule at the department and college level. These include the academic activities, college festivals, society events, and also administrative tasks and their respective deadlines.

### FEEDBACK SYSTEM

The feedback system was recommended and established last year with an objective to provide a channel of communication between alumni, corporate entities, which visit college for recruitments, students and the college administration. The feedback form link is available online on college website.
