This 32-hour certificate course is designed for undergraduate and postgraduate students of humanities and social sciences. It draws upon the expertise of scholars and practitioners in visual arts and literature from across the nation aiming to:

- Define visual arts as a distinct domain of inquiry within humanities and social sciences.
- Examine literature and visual arts as interconnected fields of study, considering how art history has profoundly influenced literary history across various genres.
- Trace key movements in art history and explore their linkages with historical developments.
- Equip participants with the grammar and vocabulary of art appreciation, such as line, colour, and depth of field.
- Engage with a range of theoretical frameworks in art history and criticism.
- Demonstrate how visual arts research impacts not only academia but also public art programs, gallery exhibitions, and art education.
- Introduce participants to emerging research trajectories in South Asian visual arts.
- Identify challenges faced by researchers using digital archives and suggest strategies to navigate these issues.

Through intensive two hour lectures, scholars will focus on four major modules, namely the critical vocabulary of art appreciation; art theory and criticism; intersections of art and literature; research possibilities in visual arts. This comprehensive 32 hour online course will serve as a launch pad for students interested in practice and research in this field.

At the end of the course, students who have more than 85% attendance will be tested on their knowledge and awarded completion certificates from the Student Learning Centre, Hansraj College, University of Delhi.

Registration will be online. Since we have limited seats, early registration is encouraged to confirm participation.
