## PARENTS' FEEDBACK SURVEY RESULTS

## 2022-2023

Parents' feedback was gathered, assessing various parameters on a five-point scale. Remarkably, parents expressed immense pride in their children's opportunity to study at Hansraj College. Positive statements predominantly received ratings of 4 or 5 on the $1-5$ scale, where 5 signifies highly favorable, 4 represents favorable, and 3 denotes satisfactory. Combining these responses, $88 \%$ of parents found the college environment conducive to teaching and learning processes. An overwhelming 95\% observed significant development in their ward's overall personality since joining the college. Additionally, $88 \%$ acknowledged the college's promotion of self-study and a genuine orientation toward research. 79\% recognized the college's satisfactory system for monitoring student progress, while $85 \%$ believed Hansraj provides value-based education. Furthermore, 89\% agreed that the college offers adequate provisions to enhance technical knowledge and communication skills. In assessing infrastructure facilities, the majority of parents found learning resources, including internet access, library resources, and computer availability, to be favorable or highly favorable, along with favorable discipline practices implemented in the college.
