TEACHER'S FEEDBACK SURVEY RESULTS

2022-2023

A feedback form was administered to determine the participation of Hansraj College Teachers' in the curriculum development process of the University and their views on the quality of the curriculum. A total of 44 teachers participated in the survey. The teachers were given 9 statements with a 5 point scale of Strongly Agree to Strongly Disagree.

Results reveal that in terms of quality of curriculum, majority of the respondents are satisfied and believe that the curriculum does value addition. 50% of the respondents agreed that course curriculum is well designed and responds to the emerging research and practical application needs of the field, 54% agreed that syllabus has good balance between theory and application. 61% agreed that the prime objectives and course outcomes are effectively addressed in each unit. 52% agreed that high quality resources are aptly available for the syllabus. 55% agreed that the programme outcomes and learning outcomes are consistent with the course and 44% agreed that the curriculum design is contemporary and focuses on employability.

Results for participation in curriculum development revealed that 45% of the respondents agreed that they have the freedom to propose, modify, suggest and incorporate modifications in the syllabus through proper forum. 50% of the respondents contributed to the curriculum and/or syllabus development. 41% agreed that University Course Committee incorporates their suggestions regarding changes/updation in the syllabus.














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<u>CHART 5: THE SYLLABUS HAS GOOD BALANCE BETWEEN THEORY AND APPLICATION</u>








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<u>CHART 7: HIGH QUALITY RESOURCES ARE APTLH AVAILABLE FOR THE SYLLABUS</u>


