Alumni Feedback Report (2024-25)

This report summarizes the feedback received from our alumni through a structured feedback form floated for the academic session 2024-25. Thirteen alumni, spanning graduating batches from the 1970s through 2025 and representing Economics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Botany, Zoology, and Commerce, responded to the survey. Given the smaller sample size relative to other stakeholder groups, the findings below are indicative of alumni sentiment, and the College will continue to encourage wider alumni participation in future survey cycles. The feedback provides insight into the relevance of the curriculum, its alignment with industry needs, and alumni experiences with college facilities.

Feedback Analysis and Key Findings

Relevance of Syllabus to Employability: The overwhelming majority of respondent alumni (92.3%) agreed or strongly agreed that the syllabus for their course was relevant to employability, reaffirming a strong alignment between the curriculum and job-market requirements.

Alignment with Industry Practices: Alumni views on the syllabus's alignment with contemporary industry practices were similarly positive, with 92.3% agreeing or strongly agreeing, suggesting continued relevance of the curriculum to evolving industry trends.

Development of Entrepreneurial Skills: The curriculum's role in fostering entrepreneurial ability received moderately positive feedback, with 61.5% of alumni in agreement an opportunity to further strengthen entrepreneurship-oriented components of the curriculum through more targeted initiatives.

Encouragement of Innovative Thinking: Feedback on the encouragement of innovative thinking was strongly positive, with 84.6% of respondents agreeing or strongly agreeing, reflecting the academic framework's continued emphasis on nurturing creativity and logical reasoning.

Inclusion of Skill Enhancement Subjects: 69.2% of alumni agreed that the syllabus included relevant skill-enhancement subjects, a positive trend with continued room to expand this aspect of the curriculum.

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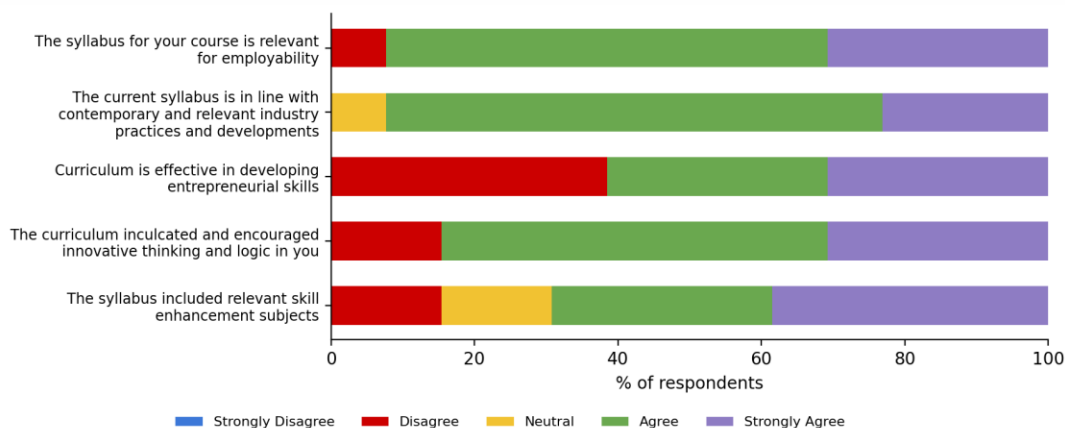
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Graph 1: Alumni feedback on curriculum relevance and design (n=13)

Connection with the College

Alumni also rated their broader connection with the College highly. On a scale of 1–5, alumni gave an average rating of 4.62 for the extent to which their learning at Hansraj contributed to their achievements in life, 4.62 for the pride and affection they feel as part of the alumni circle, 4.77 for their willingness to contribute to the College's development, and 4.85 for their willingness to deliver guest lectures or motivational talks for current students — reflecting strong alumni goodwill and a valuable resource for continued institutional engagement.

Looking Back: Experience as Students

Reflecting on their time as students, alumni rated their subject faculty and teaching staff most highly (average 4.85 out of 5), followed by library facilities (4.69) and the warmth and accessibility of professors (4.69). Course coverage (4.62), discipline and regularity (4.46), infrastructural facilities (4.18), and overall college administration (4.15) were also rated favourably. Career counselling and guidance for higher studies received a comparatively moderate average rating of 3.46, indicating an opportunity to strengthen structured career-guidance support for students — an area the College will prioritise going forward. The overall rating of the College by alumni remained strongly favourable, at an average of 4.77 out of 5, with 92.3% rating it 4 or 5.

Alumni Suggestions

A few alumni also shared specific suggestions, including a greater role for the Alumni Association in College affairs, and requests to update department-listing options (e.g., B.Sc. General streams, Life Sciences) in future survey forms, feedback the College will factor into subsequent data collection.
