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<p>Criteria 1 : Curricular Aspects</p>	<p>It is good that each teacher makes a modular plan for the teaching according to the credits. <p>Criteria 2 : Teaching Learning and Evaluation</p>	<p>The result analysis has been done properly. But the data of some meritorious students and rank holders need to be highlighted. The peer-peer mentoring program is running well. However, there is not sufficient data on mentor-mentee program and case-studies need to be highlighted.</p>
<p>Criteria 3 : Research, Innovations and Extensions</p>	<p>Research program is going well. Many faculties have research projects from external funding agencies. Also, doing collaborative work with other institutions/depts. The college has started a very innovative program of funding for some selected projects where students are also involved. Faculty have also published good number of papers in international journals of repute.</p>

<p>Criteria 5 : Student Support and Progression</p>	<p>A good number of students are getting scholarship from the government and other agencies. Students have been asked to take classes of other junior students to develop teaching skills. Some students do research projects/dissertations. They have been exposed to research by visiting research institutions like NPL, IUAC, etc.</p>
