Action Taken Report 2022-23

1. IQAC has played a crucial role in the successful implementation of NEP 2020 from the academic session 2022-23 with the introduction of a four-year undergraduate programme in aligned with University of Delhi.
2. In order to provide a platform through which undergraduate students, research scholars and faculty can publish their scholarly findings, Hansraj college has its own research journal HansShodhSudha. This year, the other **double-blind peer-reviewed academic journal** titled *HRC Journal of Economics and Finance* was launched where research papers and articles are invited especially on topics related to the field of economics, business and management for its quarterly journal publication. It has received ISSN Number 2583-8814. Further, in order to motivate faculty and students for inter-disciplinary research and innovation amongst the faculty members and students. During the year, invitation for research proposal was advertised for faculty members individually or in collaboration with other faculties from different departments. The screening is still in the process. Additionally, Research Development Cell launched Research Excellence awards for the foundation day 2023. These awards are given to highly deserved individuals who have rendered exemplary research contributions/activities to the College.
3. The Student Learning Center (SLC) fosters our students' intellectual and personal growth.

It closes learning gaps and promotes interdisciplinary subject learning. An introduction and engagement session regarding the Student Learning Center was scheduled for February 21, 2023, for first-year students. Last year, SLC initiated the Peer-Peer Mentoring Program, the goal is to improve undergraduate teaching and learning in all subject areas. It creates one-on-one relationships between students who are mentees and mentors. The objective is to foster critical thinking, reasoning skills, teamwork, and cognitive talents in the students. Several departments continued to conduct peer to peer mentoring sessions. Furthermore, on January 24, 2023, a practical workshop named "Formulation of Herbal Soaps" was held under the canopy of Peer-to-Peer Mentoring where students helped their peers to formulate the herbal soaps using natural products such as Rose, Aloe-Vera etc.

4. Regular audits are carried out in the administrative and academic domains. An external academic audit covering the previous five academic years was carried out during the second week of November 2022, while an internal audit covering the most recent academic session was carried out in October 2022. Academic auditing guarantees that the teaching-learning process is carried out efficiently in every department. On November 21, 2022, an administrative audit was carried out to evaluate administrative activity.
5. The IQAC has consistently assisted in faculty promotions in accordance with the University's SOPs while upholding transparency. In a recent meeting, the governing body approved the promotion of seven Associate Professors to Professor stage under the Career Advancement Scheme - 2018/2010, based on the selection committee's recommendations.
6. The mentoring program, which started in sessions 16–17, is still in operation under the auspices of IQAC. Throughout the session, each faculty member continues to mentor and assist a group of twenty-five students. The web-based module was further expanded to provide a broader perspective of students' overall activities, including their academic, extracurricular, sports, internship, and other involvements, as well as their holistic development. Students can submit all of their information here, including their internship, additional courses, extracurricular activities, advancement, and placement. The portal would improve the way that student data is gathered, particularly in regards to placement and advancement. The teacher who was assigned to them as a Mentor would oversee the student portal on a regular basis. Additionally, they will support and motivate them to

increase their activities.

7. IQAC team also played an important role in data submission of NIRF and India Today's Ranking.

8. On September 8, 2022, AQAR 2021–22 was successfully submitted. IQAC successfully finished all of the phases involved in NAAC cycle II, from uploading the IIQA to submitting the SSR. On September 9, 2022, the IIQA for the NAAC second cycle was successfully uploaded. On December 13, 2022, SSR was successfully uploaded for the NAAC cycle II. In April 2023, a successful NAAC peer team was held on April 28 and 29. The college received a score of 3.71 (or "A++") from NAAC, indicating their appreciation for our efforts.
