Currently engaged in a research project on migration impacts of climate change in South Asia, awarded by the Indian Council of Social Science Research, Prof. Saha is a life member of the Indian Economic Association and the Indian Society for Ecological Economics.

Government Initiatives:




Leadership Vision by Prof. (Dr.) Rama:




Vote of Thanks:
