This year, a remarkable number of 23 students were benefited by the HTBF scholarship which shows the hardwork and dedication of the EU coordinator. It is worthwhile to mention the formation of a Whatsapp group (HRC Scribe Squad) by Dr Shivani Agarwal, wherein the scribes and examinees from all across the University of Delhi colleges come together in a symbiotic manner to support each other.
