

Some of the topics included sessions on Applied Chemistry, Nano Technology Based Chemistry, Breast Cancer and Forensic Chemistry. The journey involved a lot of rough turfs where we lacked cooperation among ourselves, wherein we received back lashes and bad days but as I told you we had someone inspiring us everytime and mam managed to knit us all close bringing about those regrouping sessions and meetings and asking us the updates of our proposed works.

At a point where climate change is the inevitable end to mankind, it is highly important to be aware about what is happening and what is going to be the outcome of such a defining issue.
