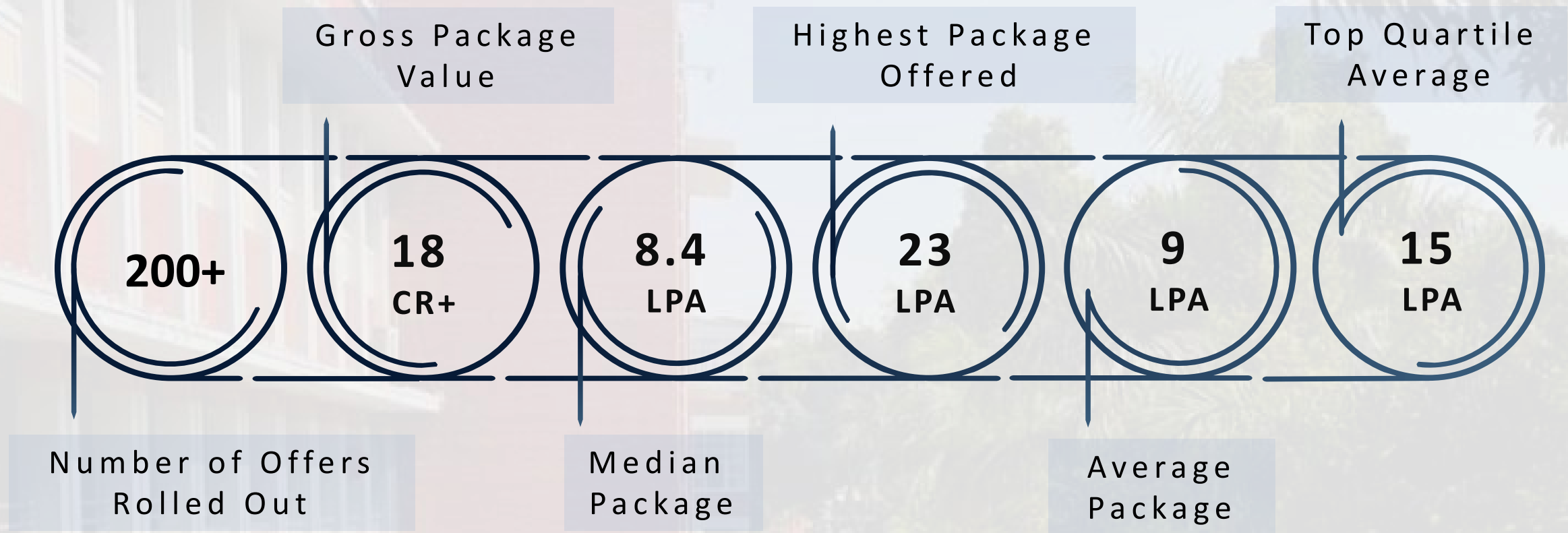

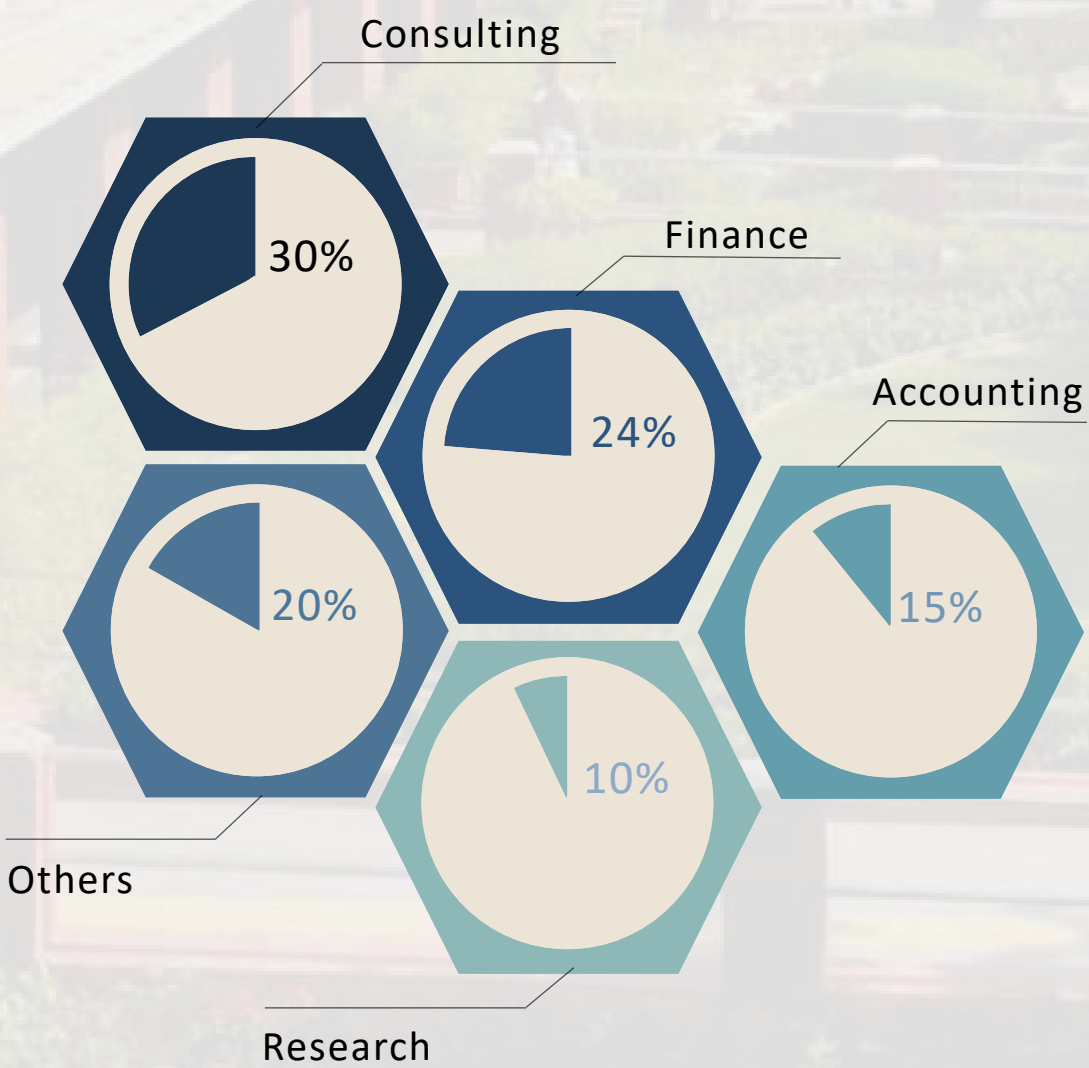

Career Pathways for Chartered Accountants By Mr. Prashanth Agarwal

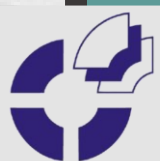
Gandhian Fellowship By Ms. Aaina Singhal
