### Viksit Bharat @2047- Action Taken Report

Viksit Bharat@2047 is the vision of the Government of India to make India a developed nation by 2047, the 100th year of its independence. Under the leadership of Prof (Dr.) Rama – Principal, Hansraj College and guidance of Prof (Dr.) Vijay Rani Rajpal - Vice-Principal Hansraj College, to channelise the innovative ideas of the youth into nation-building, the following actions have been undertaken:

#### **Accomplishments**

- Bulk mail has been sent to all the students of Hansraj College, informing them about the Vikisit Bhatat-2047 vision of Government. Video showcasing mission of Viksit Bharat and Scan code for registration was also shared with students.
- 2. Till date more than 650 students have registered on MyGov portal.
- A webpage of ViksitBharat@2047 has been created on college website to create awareness and to keep everyone updated about the progress of Viksit Bharat campaign at Hansraj College.

- Organized a one-week (8th-12th January 2024) workshop for non-teaching staff on 'ICT Tools and Artificial Intelligence' under Viksit Bharat@2047, under the aegis of IQAC and Mahatma Hansraj Malviya Mission Teacher Training Centre (MH-MMTC), Hansraj College.
- 5. Organized an online webinar for the faculty members on the theme "Decoding the role of higher education to make India a developed country" on 18th January 2024, attended by faculty members of Hansraj College and other DU colleges. Further teachers were also requested to devote 10 mins to discussing Viksit Bharat in the classroom.
- Organized an online webinar for teachers and students on the theme "Viksit Bharat@2047 - Social and Legal Perspectives" on 2nd February 2024, led by Mr Chandra Shekhar Yadav, advocate Supreme Court, an esteemed alumnus of Hansraj College.

- Organized a national seminar on 'Diversity in Unity: Empowering the bond of Ek Bharat Shreshth Bharat through South of India' on 5th February 2024, under Viksit Bharat@2047.
- 8. Created a PowerPoint presentation documenting the success stories of various government schemes and the growth story of India to orient the students towards the existing status of development in different fields. This will motivate students to participate in the idea generation contest.
- All participants including NSS volunteers, NCC cadets, faculty, students and staff members took a pledge for Viksit Bharat on 26<sup>th</sup> January 2024, during the Republic Day celebrations.
- 10. Student ideation club has been established and Ms. Vanshika Sharma (student of final year chemistry hons) has been appointed as student coordinator.
- 11. Selfie points have been established in the library ground floor, and the front lawns of Hansraj College, students and faculty members have been encouraged to click selfies and post them on various social media platforms using the Viksit Bharat hashtag.
- 12. Created a WhatsApp group consisting of all Class Representatives (CRs) of all courses across all years, and a group of teacher convenors and student presidents of all societies and committees to easily disseminate information regarding the Viksit Bharat Campaign. Also Shared Viksit Bharat video requesting them to play it at the beginning of every programme.

#### **Upcoming**

- Preparing to launch 'Idea-thon'-Competition for best idea for Viksit Bharat across 5 themes. Created a QR-code-based Google form for students to capture their ideas for the same.
- Planned an orientation of students for participation in Vikisit Bharat-2047 mission on 16th February 2024.
- Department of Botany of Hansraj College has planned an annual national conference on 'Advances in Plant Biology (APB 2024): Innovations and Strategies for Sustainable Agricultural Productivity for Viksit Bharat@2047' in collaboration with Mahatma Hansraj Malviya Mission Teacher Training Centre (MH-MMTC) on February 10, 2024.

 Besides, Debates, Nukkad Natak and Mascot Competition have been planned in the current academic session to increase the involvement of students in the Viksit Bharat@2047 Campaign.
